However, in order to defend marriage properly, homosexuality must be addressed. It is my hope to effectively convey my argument with love and respect. I intend to defend the Design of marriage; the layout of my argument is as follows: For Christians like myself, we have only three options by which to live out our beliefs: For me, the first option is the only option. The reason I collected Truth and compiled this argument is because a year old girl whom I love with all my heart asked me what I thought about gay people. In many other articles by different sources, the number is much higher. I am merely responding to a demand for us to approve of something we believe to be wrong. Nowadays, even the most fair, gentle, balanced statement can be labeled as hate speech; however, my belief is not born from bigotry and should not be passed off as prejudice. Using critical thinking, it is my hope that I can explain the reasoning behind the belief for the Design of marriage and the necessity to defend the definition of marriage. It implies a phobic condition that the accused person most likely does not truly possess. The argument prematurely assumes that a negative response to homosexuality can be construed as a phobia. Would it be a prejudice or phobia or could the rejective response simply be conviction and comprehension? There is a difference between belief and bigotry. I know many people on a personal level who proclaim themselves to be homosexuals and not one of them is a bad human being in my opinion ; in fact, all of them possess good qualities and I would consider them to be my friends. This argument is not against homosexuals; rather, it is for the intended Design of marriage. Marriage is important to defend because the disintegration of the definition of marriage will create at least three catastrophic consequences: Again, I intend to defend the Design of marriage; the layout of my argument is as follows: In order to defend marriage and also encourage the growth of better marriages, we must first know the definition of marriage. Can the undefined be defended? How can we defend what we ourselves do not understand? Even if one rejected GOD, Truth about marriage would still be evident. Ancient thinkers such as Xenophanes, Socrates, Plato, Aristotle, Musonius Rufus, and Plutarch reached remarkably similar views of marriage. Marriage should be defined as a covenant between one male and one female, both being of a proper age of maturity that would enable a mutual consent to a lifelong partnership that is designed to unite the two as one in a committed relationship. The union of the two as one should not be detached, divided, disconnected or divorced unless death separates them or the sin of sexual immorality defiles the covenant and creates a chasm between the commitment that would cause division. What about same-sex marriage? What about marriage equality? Is the definition of marriage discrimination against homosexuals? In short, the definition of marriage does not discriminate against anyone or anything found beyond the boundaries of the definition. Exclusion does not equate to discrimination. Truth is absolute and narrowly defined see the argument on absolute Truth. And what is right is right and what is wrong is wrong see the argument on moral relativism. For example, electrical conductivity can provide an analogy to better help us understand the Design. For a copy machine to produce a copy, it must first be connected to power. Without that correct connection, the copy machine will not produce a copy. Likewise, humans are males and females, possess male and female parts, and reproduction will not occur unless the correct connection is established. Of course two males or two females could adopt a child. There are many options that could be used to obtain children; however, those options are only stealing from the Design and therefore concede that the Design is good and necessary. Magnets have two poles: M attracts F; F attracts M. But M repels M and F repels F. People found outside the defined boundaries of marriage are simply unqualified to exist within the definition. Every definition of marriage excludes someone. For example, many advocates of same-sex marriage think marriage should exclude polygamous and polyamorous couples. Also, almost everyone thankfully believes marriage should exclude underage and incestuous couples. Marriage cannot mean everything or everyone, or else marriage means nothing. Redefining marriage would ultimately teach that marriage is about emotional union and cohabitation, without any inherent connections to

bodily union or family life. If marriage is centrally an emotional union, rather than one inherently ordered to family life, it becomes much harder to show why the state should concern itself with marriage any more than with friendship. Same-sex marriage is now legal, but should it be? Same-sex marriage should be legal if marriage is only a way that the government acknowledges feelings of love and affection between people. The distinctions made between relationships can either be based on essential qualities or arbitrary qualities. Essential qualities qualify and are essential in order to define. Disqualifications within definitions does not constitute as discrimination. Truth is absolute and never relative. Truth is narrow and exact, but determining right from wrong is necessary and loving, not hateful. Why should marriage be defined as being one male and one female? Why not two males or two females? Again, the central issue is the definition of marriage itself. Two males together do not qualify and neither do two females together. If marriage were only about companionship, there would be nothing to distinguish it from other very important, human unions. In other words, is marriage a cultural construct we can redefine at will such as which side of the road we drive on , or a feature of reality we discover and describe such as gravity? The definition of marriage can be discovered and described by examining biology, anthropology, and the Bible. People possess free will and are able to pursue any path they choose; however, we cannot grant their demand that the Design for marriage and family be revised to suit what is natural to them, yet unnatural in fact. What is the purpose of marriage? Love may be a reason to get married, but it is not a function of marriage. One of the functions of marriage between a male and a female is procreation. Because sexual intercourse is the only biological process that leads to procreation, this implies that marriage requires gender diversity. Male and male cannot accomplish this for sperm and sperm cannot unite and form a baby. Female and female cannot procreate because egg and egg cannot unite and form a baby. Only the combination of male and female sperm and egg can produce offspring. Severing the tie between marriage and children compromises the role marriage plays in securing the future of a culture and furthers the destructive notion that marriage is just about furthering personal happiness. But happiness is merely pleasure without purpose. Plus, it obscures that one function of marriage that clearly demonstrates why marriage requires a male and a female. It is the coordination toward a single end that makes the union; achieving the end would deepen the union but is not necessary for it. It is that, like a ball and socket, they fit together. It is the Design. Another function of male and female marriage is to regulate sexuality and confine the act of sexual intercourse to the husband and wife. By regulating sexual intercourse within the confines of marriage drastically reduces or nearly eliminates the risk of sexually transmitted diseases. Further, by regulating sexual intercourse within the confines of marriage, it enables a happier and healthier committed and relationship between parents; consequently, children have happier and healthier parents. Both father and mother influence their children in different and essential ways that are necessary for healthy child development. Today is National Book Lovers Day, so of course we wanted to give a shout out to the three books that brought us all together Fifty Shades of Grey, Fifty Shades Darker, and Fifty Shades Freed.

I read romance novels. Most every night after my brain is too spent I curl up with fanfiction on my iPad. And I have been curious about the 50 Shades books. And, when it comes right down to it, the Fifty Shades trilogy is some pretty standard fanfiction. So, what follows is my analysis of Fifty Shades of Grey as framed by fanfiction. Consider it a primer for those unfamiliar with fanfiction. Please keep in mind I know relatively little about the development process of the Fifty Shades of Grey from Master of the Universe. I write this with the caveat that this is framed by my own personal experience with fanfiction over the past decade or more. This is some general reactions. This is going to be long enough as it is. Feel free to skim like I do most fanfiction. Anyway, with that I give you my thoughts: The Basics With the blurring of mainstream entertainment and fandom a lot of these terms have blended over into the everyday. Here are some common terms: Shipâ€” A romantic relationship within a fandom that one roots for. This does not have to be a cannon relationship. Fluffâ€” A cutesy piece. There will be nothing dirty here. Smutâ€” This means the same in the fanfiction world as the real one. PWPâ€” porn without plot WIPâ€” work in progress, an uncompleted fanfiction Character Development Okay, in fanfiction you are basically always approaching the characters you read about with all of the baggage of cannon attached. So, even when they are OOC, like in 50 Shades, they still come with all that baggage. With 50 Shades as fanfiction, we are conditioned to like Christian because we like Edward. We accept Anna as clumsy even with only a few shoddy anecdotes because Bella is clumsy. There are some very well-developed characters in fanfiction. But they still come with baggage , or that their development is enriched based on all this common history. This is further complicated by 50 Shades being a Twilight fanfiction. Bella has often been accused of being a Mary-Sue in her own story. Stephenie Meyer herself has said that she left the edges of Bella intentionally vague so that teenage girls could see themselves in her. Stephanie Meyer made a specific choice for Bella, but then E. James built Anna on top of her. In fanfiction, an attachment to the characters already exists. Thus, they become almost like paper dolls in which writers can manipulate them into various desired scenarios. Often times these scenarios play out as variations on a theme. Additionally, in fanfiction, characters outside of the main characters, or our couple, can often start to feel like stock characters. Characters added to the story for a fanfiction are most of the time simply a device. Timing and Plot Fifty Shades of Grey as a novel and as a series is long, and not much really happens in the way of a standard plot, even putting it up against your typical contemporary romance novel. But considered within the fanfiction framework, it makes sense. In a fanfiction focused on a romantic relationship, which 50 Shades is, the story centers around that romance. This can move very quickly in terms of the story arc and the timeline of the story itself, both of which are the case in 50 Shades. Sometimes, if a fanfiction author is writing as they publish, the ebb and flow of this is by the demand of readers. But then the author is faced with the challenge of keeping it interesting. At times the plot can feel meandering. Some fanfiction authors plot out where they plan to go well in advance, or have their entire story written before posting. Others create as they go along, and readers can be subjected to the dreaded writers block hiatus. Writers often want to keep their readers happy while satisfying their own narrative, and will do what they can to both satisfy readers, and torment them by throwing in obstacles to their couple. Even if these obstacles seem like a stretch of plausibility to the world the writer has created. Not too unlike a soap opera. At a certain point, the characters are together and most of the internal obstacles of the relationship have been resolved. This is often where outside influences come into play. Popular outside influences include the jealous ex or a person who becomes obsessed with one of the partners. These are often used to reinforce the desirability of the main characters. Look how awesome it is that these two people everyone wants are together. Or, look how awesome it is that this somewhat mousy, uninteresting person attracts someone so out of their league. Again, nothing really revolutionary here. This is also popular because it reinforces desirability. Gender Dynamics There are whole essays about gender and feminism in 50 Shades. Would Christian Grey be as attractive without all the bells

and whistles? Which I also find problematic. A classic fanfiction caricature, sure. But I need more than that. But, with BDSM thrown into the picture, it becomes a ballgame with higher stakes. Especially when many in the BDSM community have expressed their concern for the way their lifestyle is portrayed in these books, and voiced worries that people will attempt to unsafely enter into the lifestyle. Somewhere along the way BDSM has become a popular subgenre of fanfiction in many fandoms. It is especially popular within the slash community where the power dynamics are a whole different ballgame. Sex in Fanfiction There are fanfictions that feature no sexual relationships. There are fanfictions that are only sex scenes. There is sex in fanfiction. Fanfiction allows people to explore sexuality and romances anonymously and with no one presumably judging their reading histories. Or lots of money. In fanfiction our deepest desires can become true. This is the obvious wish fulfillment in the 50 Shades series. Suspension of Disbelief With all of this, 50 Shades, and fanfiction at large asks you to suspend your disbelief. Fanfiction gives us the ability to play out our deepest desires, and the power of the internet allows us to instantly share these. I would like to emphasize that all I have explored in no way intends to diminish the work or art of fanfiction writers. They are getting no monetary reward from the endeavor. I would not have continued reading fanfiction for over a decade if there was not something intriguing, and liberating, in the form. I have a lot of thoughts on the fanfiction community. Reading about a couple with this level of insecurity became more and more excruciating, with them each reaffirming their commitment to each other again and again. I mean, Christian proposes to Ana because he thinks that only when she is his wife, will she truly be his forever. Also, Ana became obsessed with touching Christian on the chest. I wanted to physically shake Ana at one point and tell her to leave the poor man alone! Give the poor guy a break and stop sending mixed signals already. This constant back and forth got old really quickly. Everything in between these subplots was pretty much a repeat of Fifty Shades of Grey though. That meant the constant sex became boring very quickly and I actually skim read those scenes. On the whole, the book was more interesting than Fifty Shades of Grey. If you want to read about sex, own it and read the Fifty Shades trilogy.
