

## Chapter 1 : Photoshop Keyboard Shortcuts Cheat Sheet - Eric Renno

*The Basic Photoshop CS5 Commands. Getting familiar with the Photoshop CS5 application window is a great way to get your bearings before diving into Photoshop's tools and commands.*

The following are 22 of my most commonly used Photoshop Keyboard shortcuts. These are simple commands that are pretty easy to pull off, and they will certainly speed up your productivity and workflow. Command Shift S Save for Web: Command Shift Option S Undo: Command Z Step Back: Command Option Z Duplicate: Command J Duplicate all visible Layers: Command H Default Colors: D black and white Flip Foreground and Background colors: X Hand tool while in another tool: Hold Spacebar Fill with Background color: Command Delete Fill with Foreground color: Option Delete Open Fill dialog box: Shift Command D Move tool while in painting tool: Caps Lock Lock transparent pixels: Shift and same as above Fit To Screen: Command 1 Load Channel as a selection: When the Move tool is active press any of the arrow keys to move 1 pixel in that direction. Hold Shift to move 10 pixels at a time. If the Move tool is not active hold Command and then tap on the arrow keys, and hold shift to move 10 pixels at a time. Move duplicate of selection 1 px: Command Option any of the 4 arrow keys Move duplicate of selection 10 px: Move view to upper-left corner: Home Move view to lower-right corner: End Scroll up 1 Screen: Page Up Scroll down 1 screen: Page Down Scroll left 1 screen: Command Page Up Scroll right 1 screen: Fill with background color: Shift Backspace Sample as background color: Shift [ or Shift ] Switch between preset Brushes: Option Eraser Tool Cycle through blend modes: Select all Opaque Pixels: Command click on Layer Thumbnail Inverse: Command Shift D Feather Selection: Shift F6 Draw Marquee from Center: Hold Option Add to a Selection: Shift Subtract from a Selection: Option Intersect with a Selection: Shift-Option Move Selection in 1-pixel Increments: Arrow Keys Move Selection in pixel Increments: Shift Arrow Keys Move Marquee while drawing selection: Hold Space Select layer luminosity: Command Shift C Align Left: Command Shift L Align Right: Command Shift R Justify par. *Selection Tricks in Photoshop CS5. Say you want to work on a part, or selection, of an image instead of the whole photo. Photoshop CS5 has a large group of selection commands and tools.*

Set kerning Vertical scale Baseline shift Align paragraph Set tracking Indentation Horizontal scale Font color Font formats Language setting Set antialias Format the text used in an image, including font type and color, line spacing, and scale. Hyphenate breaks Crop C: Remove parts of an image Healing Brush J: Correct imperfections with pixels from another image Patch: Repair selected area with pixels from a different area Clone Stamp S: Copy areas of an image and apply them elsewhere Press and click to define the source area Pattern Stamp: Paint a predefined pattern, or create a custom pattern Eraser E: Erases pixels to the background color layer Background Eraser: Paints the background color or erases pixels Magic Eraser: Converts the selected image area to transparency Context menu. Select a rectangular pixel area Elliptical Marquee: Select an elliptical pixel area Single Row or Column Marquee: Selects a horizontal or vertical row of pixels Paragraph spacing Format paragraphs properties, such as indentation, alignment, and paragraph spacing. Smooth defined edges Sharpen: Focus soft edges Smudge: Smear pixels Move V: Click and drag to move selection Magic Wand W: Select a pixel area of similar coloring Slice K: Draw a slice area Slice Select: Select and resize or relocate a slice Paintbrush B: Draw soft brush strokes Pencil: Draw hardedged freeform shapes History Brush Y: Paint from a previous history state or snapshot. Select the state or snapshot from the History palette. Similar to the History brush, but with more options Gradient G: Click and drag to fill with gradient of foreground and background colors Paint Bucket: Click on an object and fill with foreground color Dodge O: Lighten areas of the image Burn: Darken areas of the image Sponge: Decrease or increase pixel color Horizontal or Vertical Type T: Insert text in the image Horizontal or Vertical Type Mask: Insert transparent text in the image Rectangle U: Draw a rectangle filled with foreground color. Press to draw a square Rounded Rectangle: Draw a rectangle with rounded corners Select vectors, subpaths, or shapes Pen P: Click to add points to a path Freeform Pen: Draw a freeform path Add Anchor Point: Click on a path to insert anchor point Delete Anchor Point: Click on anchor point to delete from path Convert Point: Smooth a corner point, or sharpen a curve point continued Ellipse: Draw an oval shape. Press to draw a circle. Draw a polygon shape Line: Draw a line Custom Shape: Create a shape or insert a predefined custom shape Notes N: Insert an invisible text note Audio Annotation: Insert an audio comment Eyedropper I: Click the eyedropper cursor on the color you want to apply to the foreground Color Sampler: Click on the image and look at the Info palette to view the color information Measure: Click and drag to measure distances, angles, the image in the Info palette. Click and drag to move around in the page Zoom Z: View the document close-up or far away Set foreground color: Used for stroke and fill Switch background and foreground colors X Set default colors: Change to black and white Set background color.
