Second floor of the courthouse. Do you have a degree? Do you have children? What school district do they attend? Campos is married to Connie Campos. I was the emergency management coordinator for my agency, the Texas Parks and Wildlife. So, I am familiar with the responses that are required when a disaster hits. I am familiar with the fact that, when a disaster does hit, a lot of times the public is left without roads or with damaged roads. Utilities are a problem. So they look to the government to get the utilities back again, to get the transportation systems. That is a big part of that job. Another thing is financial and budgeting. As such we had to look at how much we would spend on salaries, equipment and utilities. You had to keep in mind the limitations you had on your spending and how you were going to make that work to have a smooth operation year round. As far as personnel management, we did many hiring processes for game wardens. Then down the road it would include disciplinary actions and how that all works within an organization from coaching an employee even to termination. Why are you running for county judge? I saw this as an opportunity to utilize some of the skills that I had from my previous career. I felt that they matched well with the duties of a county judge. That is where my passion is. I understand the intricacies, the fact that you are in the spotlight at all times. At any time the public could complain on you because you are a public servant. What are the responsibilities of the county judge? He, along with the four county commissioners, runs the business side of the county, which is a multi-million dollar budget each year. They set or help set the budget for all of the departments for all of the elected officials. They vote on the major purchases and acquisitions. The county judge is probably the biggest source of information for any business having to do with the county. Do you view the county judge as a full or part-time job? How would being elected affect your current career? I do have a county job, and I would be prohibited from holding my current job. How do you view the pay scale of the county judge position? I accept it for what it is. Having said that, that will be my main source of income. What would your number one priority be if you were elected? I would like to see those that want to have input know what the issue are beforehand so that they can come and testify before the judge and the commissioners if they are so inclined. I want obviously to promote transparency so that the public does in fact know what issues are on the table and what is being decided, what is being discussed and what is being voted on. Are you a conservative or liberal? I consider myself pro-life. I consider a valid marriage as one between a man and a woman. I have Christian values, family values. Then, on the fiscal issues, I understand that taxing is a serious issue, and any tax increases require much consideration and debate so that you hear both sides of the issue. We have roughly 20 percent [of the county] at poverty level and a high percentage of the population on fixed income. So, any increases would burden them severely sometimes. In the last statewide primary, did you vote in the Republican or Democratic primary? What are your credentials in the Republican party? Have you read and do you agree with the party platform? Rank the following levels of government by importance: Locally is where you begin to find any of your leaders that are going to step up statewide and then nationwide. So that is the most important area. Ideally it would be state and then national because I think, as a Republican, we want the least government that we can. We can relate better to the small government. At the state level, we feel like we can get to know some of our legislators

After 73 years, Sgt. Duran was still missing. He grew up in El Rito, N. The plane was part of a formation flying from Gioia del Colle, Italy, to bomb a German aircraft factory in Regensburg. It was the final day of Operation Argument, a series of coordinated attacks to destroy German aircraft factories and cripple enemy fighter forces. Over six days, the 8th and 15th Air Forces launched a combined 3, bomber sorties against targets deep inside the Third Reich. The aircraft plunged into a steep dive and passed out of sight. Nine crew members bailed out, were captured and interrogated by the Germans. A German interrogator told several of the crew members that one body had been found in the aircraft wreckage, the report stated. The trail went cold. Pat Duran, now 63, the daughter of Gilberto, was born 10 years after Alfonso went missing. DPMO investigators conducted field research missions during the next several years, visiting the wreckage site and interviewing residents. Two were known partisans – Yugoslav revolutionary communists – and two were unknown Nazi collaborators, villagers in Pokojisce said. Investigators determined that the plane that crashed near Pokojisce was a BH. She found an email for Pat Duran and sent her a message: After difficulties and delays working with military agencies, Duran contacted Maryland Sen. Chris Van Hollen, who wrote letters to the Army. When she was 10, she saw the Nazis loading up the dead, bodies and heads separately. Her mother, she said, kept her younger siblings back but made her watch. Dragar has lived near the church since coming to Pokojisce as a young bride in His original burial site was behind the church, in a grave so shallow that she had to add soil and leaves on occasion to keep his remains covered. She tended that grave for years, she said, adorning it with candles and wreaths on special occasions. In recent years, the local municipal association assumed the duties. The new details For two days, locals came and went, curiously watching the team of Americans dig, scrape and screen rocks and dirt. In the small mountain village, nine DPAA members – including two anthropologists, a medic, linguist and explosive ordnance disposal specialist – milled about the pastoral church with shovels and buckets.
