Seventeen books have had a character with this name, frequently in the opening prologues, frequently a sailor, usually dying; a notable exception is the first in chronological order Dirk Pitt adventure, Pacific Vortex, in which Admiral Leigh Hunter is a major character, commander of the st Recovery Fleet in Hawaii. In the introduction to Arctic Drift, Cussler says there was a real Leigh Hunt who died in and the novel is dedicated to him. He also uses the name "Periwinkle" in his works.
