

Chapter 1 : Diagramming Sentences Worksheets | Grammar Practice

This is going to be our "quick" repetitive grammar practice each day at the very beginning of class. I will have a sentence on the board, and they will work with the same sentence ALL week Mon-Thurs figuring out the parts of speech, sentence parts, and sentence types.

Homophone Worksheets 1 and 2 - Write the correct form of a word to complete each sentence. Homophone Story - Finish the story using the correct homophones from the word box. Using Homophones - Select the correct homophone to complete each sentence. To, Too, and Two - Use to, too, or two when completing the sentences. Homophones Worksheet - Read each sentence and circle the homophone. Adjectives worksheet 2 - Circle the adjectives found in each sentence. Adjectives Worksheet 1 - Identify adjectives and nouns and rewrite sentences. Nouns and Plural Nouns - Identify, color, and list the nouns and plural nouns. Get Around Nouns - Circle the noun in each sentence on this transportation-themed worksheet. Nouns Worksheet 3 - This noun worksheet could be used as a worksheet or as practice for standardized tests. Why Are They Nouns? Nouns on the Farm - Fill in the blanks with nouns from the word box. Noun Clown - Students will identify the noun or nouns in each sentence. Schoolhouse Nouns - Fill in the blanks with nouns from the word box. Noun Worksheet - Identifying nouns in a sentence. Nouns at School - Write ten singular nouns and their plural form. Pronouns Worksheet - Introduction to pronouns. Proper Nouns - Circle the proper nouns in each sentence. Possessive Pronouns - Rewrite sentences replacing the underlined word with a possessive pronoun. Verbs, Adverbs Change the Tense - Rewrite sentences using different verb tenses. Select the Tense - Student will label each sentence with past, present, or future. Verbs Worksheet 1 - Identify the verbs in each sentence. Helping Verbs - Students will complete each sentence with the correct helping verb. I Am Unique - The letter I is always capitalized. Capitalization - Geography and capitalization come together on this worksheet. Back to School Capitalization - Underline the word or words in each sentence that should be capitalized. Halloween Capitalization - Underline the word or words that should be capitalized in each sentence. Positively Periods - Rewrite each sentence and place a period where required. Question or Statement - Add a question mark or a period to each statement. Unscramble a group of words to make a question and a statement. Farm Theme Questions and Statement - Write two questions and two statements about the farm picture. Punctuation Worksheet - Using a period and question mark. Recognizing Sentences Worksheet A - Identify complete sentences on this dinosaur themed worksheet. Halloween Sentences - Is it a telling sentence or a question? At the Beach - Add an exclamation point, question mark, or period to each sentence. Friends at School - Correctly use a question mark, period, or an exclamation point. Animal Race - Students will end each sentence with a period or a question mark. Sonoran Desert Question or Statement - Using a period and a question mark and write a group of words as a sentence and a question. Which Kind of Sentence - Correctly place a period or a question mark at the end of each sentence. Punctuation Practice - Students will fill in the bubble that shows the punctuation mark required to correctly complete each sentence. Punctuation Worksheet - Complete sentences using a period, question mark, or an exclamation point. Letter from San Diego - This punctuation worksheet requires students to identify words that should be capitalized and insert commas where needed. Synonyms, Antonyms Synonym Sleuth - Identify synonyms for given word and use in a sentence. Antonym Puzzle - Students will select antonyms to complete the crossword puzzle and write an antonym for ten different words. Antonym Worksheet - Write an antonym for the bold word in each sentence. Synonym Worksheet 2 - Draw a line to match the word with the same or almost the same meaning. Synonyms - Students will identify synonyms and write their own. Using Synonyms - Identify synonyms in sentence. Synonyms - Choosing the best word in sentence. Similar Words - Students will build their vocabulary when they complete each sentence using a similar word or synonym. Syllables Skateboard Fun - Circle and print the two-syllable words in the story. Animal Syllables - Count and record the number of syllables in the animal names. Vegetable Syllables - Count and tally the syllables.

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
