At the public value end of the continuum, the focus is on achieving the social outcomes sought by the community or public. Azaddin Salem Khalifa has identified four types of private value in the literature, each defined by, and useful to, different groups: Shareholder value “ defined by economists and focussing on financial markets and returns to investors. Customer value “ defined by marketers and focussing on profitable customer relationships. Stakeholder value “ defined by stakeholder theorists and focussing on social responsibilities beyond shareholder value creation and including stakeholder such as employees, consumers and society at large. It can be argued that customer value is the key to shareholder value and, therefore, customers are the most important stakeholders in determining value. Khalifa describes three categories that customer value can be grouped into: Since they are expected to be there, their presence only brings customers up to neutral but absence annoys them. As such, they are basic, must-have needs, and can drive customer dissatisfaction if they are not met. They typically meet performance related needs and customers are disappointed if these needs are poorly met but have increasing satisfaction and perhaps even delight the better these needs are met. Customers are surprised in a good way. Delighters innovatively solve a latent need of the customer. Since they are unexpected, there is no negative effect if they are absent. Benefits include the tangible and intangible attributes of the service offering. Sacrifices include monetary and non-monetary factors, such as the time and effort required to access and use the service. The judgement of value results from the trade-off in desired outcomes and costs. In considering benefits and sacrifices, four consumer definitions of value are described: Low price Focus on sacrifice. Getting whatever the consumer wanted Focus on benefits. The quality obtained for the price paid Trade-off between sacrifice and benefit. Total benefits obtained for total sacrifice incurred. This model assumes that customers access and use services to accomplish favourable ends. The choice of service is a means to enable the customer to achieve their desired end state. The customer attaches value to the service according to its perceived ability to meet their needs. The models of customer value are not intended to be stand-alone models. To be able to offer customers superior value for exchange, an organisation needs to understand how value is generated and accumulated for customers, and what forms customer value can take. The value exchange model makes sense for local government. At the end of the day, customers need to expend effort commensurate with the benefit they get. Hence, focussing on convenience in services is important. The value build up model in the next circle provides understanding of the factors that influence the accumulation

of value to the customer. This model has real significance in public services where special meaning is attached to services that transcend simple transactions between suppliers and consumers. People expect that public services treat them respectfully and observe all of their human rights. Value accrues when services support self-actualisation and the achievement of human potential. Lastly, in order to build up value, it is essential to know what elements or components create or destroy value – hence the value dynamics model. Unfortunately, outrage is not uncommon in public services. Despite growing scepticism about the efficacy of governments at all levels, people often have high expectations of the public services they will receive and how they will be treated in the process. Hart and Mark B. This is a useful model for local government where urgency, and the immediacy of council politics, often keeps management effort focussed below the horizontal line. Compliance, avoiding the attention of the local media, avoiding critical reports from State government overseers, and vocal minorities complaining about any change effectively keeps councils in the here and now. When councils fail to keep pace with changing community expectations or to deliver services in ways that meet customer expectations or to support State policy objectives, they face externally imposed change – i. At least they would have community support for resisting them. The closest approximation to shareholder value in local government is ratepayer value. Ratepayers own property and pay the land taxes that primarily fund local government services. They have a stake in the council that is different to all others. Stakeholder value The value sought by other stakeholders is nonetheless important in local government. Value is not only created for the benefit of the ratepayer, even though they are paying. This is often difficult for them to understand. The intention is to enable people to influence decisions that affect them in ways that presumably create the value they need or want from their council. The public value was concept pioneered by Mark H. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University. He describes the aim of managerial work in the public sector as creating public value for the community. This is the equivalent of managers in the private sector creating private value for shareholders. Only then can we be sure that some public value has been created. This is a structured process to measure the public value created and, surprisingly, setting up the measures seems to be the best way to focus on creating it. The concept of public value is easy enough to understand but identifying and describing public value has proven to be difficult. However, if you start with the measures it defines itself. Moore defines public value as the collective view of the public or community about what they regard as valuable, especially with regard to the use of public money and authority. He sets out four key requirements of public managers in creating public value: Articulate a clear, complete and compelling idea of the public value to be produced. Develop a set of measures to record performance in producing that value. Invite and embrace external accountability for defining and creating value. Create management systems that distribute internal accountability for value creation across managers and employees so that they feel motivated to perform in the short-term and to innovate and learn over the long-term. A process is required to determine what constitutes public value for each community that includes ways to check in periodically to stay in touch and be responsive to changes in needs and expectations. A serious focus on public value would help determine the operational capability required to deliver valued services and to design those services to meet expectations. Is it the individual or the collective who are the ultimate arbiter of value? Is it the satisfaction of clients or service recipients that is important or the achievement of social outcomes? Every day public servants deal with conflict between individuals and their expectations of value and the broader community value. Typically, the community expects that their taxes will pay for standardised services that are cost-efficient and equitable. When individuals want customised services that provide them with additional benefit using community resources, what are public managers to do? If the individual expectations of value are not met it will be an unsatisfactory customer experience. Creating public value can be more complicated than the equivalent private sector creation of shareholder value. The recognition of public value is further complicated by the accountability for public sector performance. Demands for accountability in the public sector are continuous and come from individuals who complain or join forces with others to form interest groups; the media amplifies the complaints of individuals and groups; councillors represent their constituents and demand

accountability; and the Ombudsman, Auditor General and Local Government Inspector are powerful external sources of accountability. The demands for accountability come from many different places and focus on different aspects of performance. Some are more disciplined and consistent than others. Ideally, these sources of accountability would integrate to form a compelling demand for performance that is focussed on an explicit public value account that clarifies expectations of public managers. However, more often auditing focuses on cost controls and procedural compliance. Politics focuses on the issues of the day. The pluralist system focuses on whatever captures the interest of any individual or stakeholder. Complaints focus on the bad experiences of individual clients. Determining whether or not public value has been provided is complex. How is value created and managed? Essay on the Meaning of Local Governments: Local governments are infra-sovereign geographic units found within sovereign nation or quasi-sovereign state. Like other units of government, local government units possess a defined area, a population, an organisation and also the authority to undertake and the power to perform public activities. Within its territory, a local government unit seeks to give opportunities to the people for the expression of their opinion in regard to local affairs. It enables them to choose their representatives to take care of local affairs on their behalf. However, it would not be correct to say that the local government shares any part of the political sovereignty of the state or the legal sovereignty of the government, within the state. It is a semi-autonomous politico-administrative territorial organisation, having come into existence in many countries as the result of decentralization of powers. In certain countries like England the process was different. Those politico-administrative organisations sprang up from the local communities. The Local Government Act, recognized county administration in England by transferring administrative powers to elective county councils. The Local Government Act, and the London Government Act, , said to be the two modern Acts of Parliament, describe the constitution of several types of public bodies concerning local government. Jackson is of the view that local government as applied to England is hardly capable of precise definition. However, the term according to him has certain implications: Second, it must have governmental character as an agency of the public to whom it must be accountable. Third, it must possess substantial autonomy. Local Government is at the bottom of a pyramid of governmental institutions with the national government at the top and intermediate governments state, regions, provinces occupying in middle range. Local Government has only a derivative and not an independent authority. Its powers and functions are determined by the state legislature and these can be altered by law. Essay on the Existing Patterns of Local Governments: There are numerous local governments in the world. Hence it is difficult to make incontrovertible generalization about the nature of local government. It is difficult even to isolate the critical variables that shape it. However, five main systems of local government may be postulated in the world, viz, unitary decentralized, napoleonic prefect, federal-decentralized, local government system of communist countries, and post-colonial systems. Integration of local and central authorities is one of the salient features of the modern English local government and that of the Scandinavian countries. The relation between the central government and the local authorities is not that of an omnipotent controlling authority and its agents but of partners in an enterprise the carrying on of efficient administration. Quite a different system or set-up prevails in France. In the words of Prof Munro: All authority converges inward and upward. This saves the local governments from rigid control, from the above. Such a system has been described as Federal-decentralized system according to the International Encyclopedia. Local Government Systems in Communist Countries: The local government systems in the communist countries are examples of de-concentration of authority rather than decentralization. In other words, the local governmental unit is an agency of the Central Government and its functions are an integral element of hierarchical administrative system of the state. The area of local independence is narrow and extends only to minor matters whereas control devices are extensive and vigorously applied. Post-colonial system is the fifth category of local governments in the world. The creation of new nations from former colonies involves varying degrees of change in local government. The legacy of colonialism is omnipresent, however much the new leaders strive for break with the colonial past. In India, with the ushering in of independent era, it is being realized increasingly that centralization has produced congestion at the centre and anemia at the periphery. It is being felt that a dynamic democracy can grow only out of meaningful relationships and spontaneous organisations that spring up among the people when they

come together at the local level to solve their basic problems by co-operation among themselves. In the words of Mahatma Gandhi, democracy can exist only on trust. That is necessary to form a stable base for the development of national democracy, and also to play an important role in the development of social and economic systems. On the whole, however, more attention seems to have been paid to the re-organisation of rural local bodies than of the urban local government. It should, however, be recognized that the processes of urbanization will gain momentum in the near future and it would have been better if local self-government may also have been mentioned in the Directive Principles. However, in industrialized countries, the number of civil servants at the local level is much larger than is commonly believed. In the United States, for example, there are four times as many local government employees as federal employees; even in a developing country, like India, the number of local level employees is as high as 40 percent that of federal employees Suicide, Local politics is a wider term and covers a host of areas besides local government. In South Asia, local government is widely known as local self-governments. For the purpose of this essay, local government is defined essentially in terms of some attributes: Constitutional and Legal Basis of Local rent In any democratic polity, local government is given legal recognition either by an act of Parliament or by incorporation of relevant provisions in the Constitution Khan, Bangladesh Constitution of clearly spelt out the legal basis and responsibilities of local government. It is necessary to mention the constitutional and legal basis of the local government of Bangladesh because if demarcated by the Constitution or by the act of the parliament, or if there is no scope for the government to decentralized powers to elected local bodies, it is difficult to devolve powers. It is evident that the legal basis of the local

government is clearly spelt out in the Constitution and the Constitution through Article 59, Chap III has ensured the devolution of power to local government bodies. The origin of the existing local government institution can be traced back to the demand for self-government in British India. Initially local government was developed by the arthritis to maintain law and order in the rural areas with the help of local elite backed by local police All, The local elites were to be nominated in the local government institutions from among those who were trusted by the colonial authority. After , Union Parish became the lowest unit of local government in Bangladesh. There are two distinct kinds of local government institution in Englanders â€” one for the rural areas and another for urban areas. The local government in the rural areas represents a hierarchical system comprising four tiers: The following figure shows the existing local government structure in Bangladesh: E British colonial administration established local governments through the Local Self-Government Act of to maximize land revenue collection and maintain law and order. Local officials during this period came from the local elite. But the process of decentralization during British rule was obscure. The British were not interested in any degree of devolution. What appears from the real practice of local bodies is a picture of oppression and exploitation. There has not been any positive result for rural people apart from the fact that these experiments served the colonial interests of the empire. Although India was the first colony to become the experimental ground for such policies of decentralization, the British reluctance to implement any real degree of decentralization is also evident. One example of such reluctance is Inch recommended an elected Penchant Tinker, Pakistan period Reforms regarding local governance were also introduced during the Pakistan period. A new system of local government, known as the system of Basic Democracies, was Introduced in the late asses. Though explicitly propagated as a programmer of decentralization, the system actually helped the military regime of General Buy Khan in extending the stronghold of bureaucracy to the local level. Though slow in progress, reforms to strengthen local governance and expand democracy were made. It was also a response to the challenge of reducing poverty. The Constitutionâ€ Gives enough opportunity to the lawmakers to develop viable self- governing local government institutions. However, as far as the implementation of the objective is concerned, the achievement is far from satisfactory. The system of basic democracies was abolished and government bodies carried over from the days prior to independence were dissolved. The committees created would, for the interim, perform local functions. This provided for a three-tier system with a directly elected Union Parish Council , Than development committee under the control of the sub-divisional officer, and Gila Parish under the control of deputy commissioner. Music paid more attention to national than local issues. Although the Union Parish Council was designed as a decentralized body of local government and the election in was to ensure grassroots democracy, the Miami League did not hold elections to the higher level councils, nor did it take any measures to devolve authority to any of them. Aziza played a critical role in reviving the local government institutions in the country. The Local Government Ordinance , promulgated by Aziza, created Gram Kasbah village councils in an attempt to decentralized government down to the village level. In , two years after General Aziza became the elected president, all the Gram Kasbah were transformed into Gram Karakas village government in each of the villages of Bangladesh. The Gram Karakas was a body consisting of gram piranha village executive and 11 elected members representing different classes of the village. The Gram Karakas was a mini- government which could undertake planning and promotional programmer Chowder, The reforms initiated by Gene. Aziza were different from the earlier policies of decentralization. The bureaucracy was given a free hand to control the local councils once again. These bodies of local government remained as the deconsecrated form of decentralization. The only exceptions were the Union Parishes and Gram Karakas. The Gram Karakas had many characteristics common to those of Manhood model of decentralization. Lieutenant

General Rasher to After Gene. In his first year of office, Rasher initiated the reform measures to decentralized the administration through the abolition of former subdivisions and upgraded the arenas into Pastille sub-district. Ironically, the democratically elected government of Chalked Aziza indulged in anti-democratic practices with regard to decentralization.
