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Chapter 1 : False Prophets and False Teachers | Messiah's Mandate

False prophets lead people away from Yeshua, as do false teachers. Just as a teacher's doctrine can change over time, and he can make mistakes in his exegesis and hermeneutics, so, too, can a believer make a mistake in prophesy, repent, and be restored.

Was he a prophet of the true and living God? There are two ways to find out. First, compare what he says to Scripture and if what the Prophet teaches contradict Scripture, then he is false. The second way is to examine any prophecies that he has made. If a single prophecy fails, then the person is a false prophet. We can see that the criteria of a true prophet is not failing when predicting the future. This is because God, who is outside of time and the creator of the universe, makes no mistakes when he tells us what will happen. Therefore, if anyone claims to be a prophet of God and speaks in the name of God and gives a prophecy that fails, then the person is not of God. Did Joseph Smith make any prophecies? That is possible and such a teacher should respond to the truth with humility and deep repentance. Such a man should probably never allow himself to be caught in such a position again but refusing to publically teach. However, most false prophets glory in their prophetic calling, thinking that it elevates them above others in the body. The food of the false prophet is his arrogance and pride. What should we do when a false prophet is found in the body of Messiah? First and foremost we should not fear them. Even more than that we should not listen to them. It is not Lashon Hara to warn others of a danger. And there is nothing more dangerous spiritually than a false prophet. Let us examine the words of some self-proclaimed prophets in the Messianic Fringe and see if they meet the test of false prophet. His false prophecies which will be detailed shortly included the claim that was the beginning of the Tribulation, that the Abomination of Desolation would be set up in , and that Prince Charles of Wales was the AntiChrist. These dates were set by God when He started the 70th week. Moshe warned that false prophets would make claims in the name of haShem. Well if we read further in this same issue which Monte Judah has chosen to remove from his web site by the way we find: I am drawing a conclusion based on a Scriptural understanding. Further, I have openly called all men to examine my words and scrutinize them. If what I say does not happen, then brand me as a false prophet, listen to me no more, and heap the ridicule on to prevent others from making the same mistake. But I would remind you in accordance with the Scripture not to despise a prophetic utterance until it has been proven false" Well Monte Judah has himself called for his own branding as a false prophet! There is a simple explanation. Monte Judah tickles the ears of gentiles who want to believe they are the lost tribes of Israel. False Prophets are natural ear ticklers, feeding the lost the lies they want to hear. Warning the body of Messiah about the dangers of Monte Judah is not a popular message. But it is one that a true Shepherd must do in order to save the sheep from a deceiver. Michael Rood Michael John Rood and his ministry called Rood Awakenings has been around for a long time in different forms. Will what they are being taught now change also? Only a false prophet does. Jesus warned us by saying, "For false Christs and false prophets will appear and perform great signs and miracles to deceive even the elect--if that were possible" Matt.

We are, with some solid justification, getting pretty apocalyptic. Some very sensible, tweed-wearing and non-hysterical people are starting to talk like crazed End Times aficionados. But I want now to sound a note of caution. This situation, especially now as it escalates to previously unimaginable proportions of horror, calls for us to become even more sober and more careful and more precise than we have ever been before. And the high production values are good too. But it steps over a line. I will grant that upon what we have seen so far, and its effects, it is indisputably just to describe Francis Bergoglio as a false prophet. These are undoubtedly extraordinary signs, and we are obviously obliged to examine them carefully and to be warned that the situation really is as apocalyptic as it looks. I call for people to be very, very careful. Not to rely exclusively on their own lights. To find well educated and faithful persons to consult when an idea pops in there. To look things up and to be extremely precise in the use of terms. To make concrete distinctions. And to make sure you know exactly what you are saying, and say only those things of which you are completely certain. And I repent of all the times I have failed to do this myself. We do no one any good whipping up hysteria. This is a time for cool heads. In these most dangerous times, the Devil can make use of any mistakes we make, to cause division and more confusion, to tempt us to turn on each other, to aim the firing squad inwards. Are more nations open to the gospel now or are more

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nations being taken over by the Muslim faith? So far the Muslim faith controls over 30 nations on 3 continents and the number is growing yearly. We only need to watch the news to see which way this nation is heading as it regards the Muslim faith. Therefore David Wilkerson is not only a false teacher he is also a false prophet which qualifies him for the following scripture: "The Lord your God is testing you to find out whether you love him with all your heart and with all your soul. 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Chapter 8 : Testing Prophecies and Prophets

Biblical Insight: False prophets are unteachable and unwilling for their prophecies to be evaluated and tested, as Scripture commands. Virtually every time New Testament Scriptures speak of prophecy, they also speak of evaluating and testing the prophecy, which is the responsibility of every believer.

We should be very very cautious of receiving so-called "words" from self-appointed prophets. I have only received three genuine "words" in my life as a Christian. That is a period of 46 years. I know they were genuine because, first of all, they agreed with what the Spirit told me very early on in my walk. Also, all 3 stated the same fact about my ministry that nobody else knew Very rarely will there be genuine prophecies that tell you who you should marry or what job you should take. Almost all genuine prophecies have to do with your ministry and are almost always confirmational in nature. If someone prophecies over you and says you should go to Africa, and the Lord has not said such a thing Receive that with a cup of salt. I think that receiving accurate prophecy is not an every day occurrence for any believer. I can say that over the last 50 years, I have had only two or three good prophecies spoken over me, and these have only been partly fulfilled. In fact, prophecy is right down there as one of the least reliable forms of guidance. It has to be confirmed by other factors: The Word of God, circumstances, concurrence of mature experienced mentors, and a strong sense of peace. This approaches the horoscope and a spirit of divination could replace genuine prophecy. Also, I will make another observation here. You have heard critics of the prophetic quoting Old Testament scriptures about false prophets, and these people have accused prophetic ministries making mistakes in their prophecies as false prophets to be condemned with the type of punishment prescribed for false prophets in the Old Testament. Nathan the prophet made a mistake when he prophesied to David that he could build the Temple. Nathan was never punished for making a mistake. God merely corrected him so that he gave a true prophecy. The Scripture says that Moses was the greatest prophet. Those who were punished were those who tried to usurp the prophetic ministry of Moses, and to use prophecy to turn people away from God to worship idols and to indulge in sexual orgies. I have studied the work of the prominent prophetic ministries of modern times, and I see no evidence of any of them using prophecy to turn people away from Christ and to wilfully commit serious sin. It is quite true that these prophetic ministries made their mistakes and learned from them. Jack Deere, one prominent ministry was quite open about the errors he made in his *Beginners Guide to the Gift of Prophecy*. He said that in most cases God allowed the errors to teach him important lessons. He said that we humans are just earthen vessels who become anointed once in a while, and that we are subject to getting the wrong end of the stick occasionally. God comes to us with grace and encouragement because He wants to work with us and develop us into effective ministries for Him. I think that those who get up on their hind legs and accuse good prophetic ministries of being false prophets when they make mistakes and set up websites to expose who they think are false prophets and teachers are just damnable religious hypocrites, full of their own pride and self aggrandisement, speaking out of a hole in their backsides. If Jesus was here, He would speak to them as harshly as He did to the hypocritical self-righteous Pharisees of His time.

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Chapter 9 : How to Identify a False Prophet

The Jehovah's Witness organization, that claims to be a prophet of God, is really a false prophet. The Witnesses make many claims in their attempt to convert you to their faith. They profess to have the only true Christian church, to be the only true representatives of God, to have the only correct biblical teaching, and to be the only true.

I think Pope Francis is the Pope who fulfills the apocalyptic prophecy during the period relating to the last Pope of the Malachy prophecy. There simply is no more room for another Pope according to this prophecy before the final events unfold. Of course, time will make things clearer as to his plans and agenda, as he moves beyond his now famous rhetoric toward implementation. So for now, I withhold any conclusions, instead giving Pope Francis the benefit of the doubt, always remaining obedient to the Church as a faithful Catholic theologian. But, alert and investigative I shall remain, and I think that if he is a valid Pope, and the prophecies are wrong and his disturbing rhetoric is just for effect, he will be glad for my vigilance on behalf of the Church. Nevertheless, it is incumbent upon me to present to you the reader some of the reasons that have led me to this current supposition. First, I will present the credible heavenly prophecies about the False Prophet, then what to expect from the False Prophet according to the prophecies, and finally how Catholics should respond to the possibility and growing concern that Pope Francis might be the False Prophet. By this, he will lead many of the faithful into heresy, and he will eventually cause the earth to honor and worship the Antichrist Rev. The Catechism confirms, saying: Objectively and of significant note, we are on the last Pope of this age according to the famous St. Malachy was a twelfth century Saint whose prophecies concerned the final Pope of our time, the Pope who will reign after Pope Benedict XVI, stating about him: In the final persecution of the Holy Roman Church there will reign Peter the Roman, who will feed his flock amid many tribulations, after which the seven-hilled city Rome will be destroyed and the dreadful Judge will judge the people. So, what does this prophecy tell us? It tells us that during the reign of Pope Francis during the period of the th pope of the prophecy , we will endure the final persecution. It is not in the future, but right now. And that Rome is about to be destroyed. This also agrees with the La Salette prophecy see below. Of the Popes in the Malachy prophecy, the last pope listed, Petrus Romanus, is the only one that did not have a number. Why would all the other popes have a number except the last pope? Is this a hint about his invalidity? More on this later. And the prophecy also tells us the Judge is returning in this generation to initiate judgment, possibly to usher in the great new Era of Peace that Our Lady of Fatima foretold. Our Lady of La Salette prophesied about the latter times: Rome will lose the faith and become the seat of the antichristâ€¦ all the universe will be struck with terror, and many will let themselves be misled. Our Lady reportedly stated through Fr. I will bring you to the full understanding of Sacred Scripture. Above all, I will read to you the pages of its last book, which you are living. I am opening for you the sealed book, that the secrets contained in it may be revealedâ€¦ So, according to this prophecy, our generation will indeed experience the final battle of the Book of Revelation, and the beginning of the millennium of peace. So, these events are upon us even now. There comes out of the earth, by way of aid to the black beast which arises out of the sea, a beast which has two horns like those of a lambâ€¦ intimately connected to that of the priesthoodâ€¦ The beast with the two horns like a lamb indicates Freemasonry infiltrated into the interior of the Church, that is to say, ecclesiastical Masonry, which has spread especially among the members of the hierarchy. This Masonic infiltration, in the interior of the Church, was already foretold to you by me at Fatima, when I announced to you that Satan would enter in even to the summit of the Church. The task of ecclesiastical Masonry is that of destroying Christ and His Church, building a new idol, namely a false christ and a false church. The Church will know the hour of its great apostasy. The man of iniquity will penetrate into its interior and will sit in the very Temple of God, while the remnant which will remain faithful will be subjected to the greatest trials and persecutions. The apostasy will be, as of then, generalized because almost all will follow the false christ and the false church. Then the door will be open for the appearance of the man or of the very person of the Antichrist! Sheen reportedly uttered a prophecy that

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confirms some details about the false prophet, and that he will come from within the Church, from one of her Bishops: A religion without a world to come. A religion to destroy religions. There will be a counterfeit Catholic church. And the False Prophet will create the other. The false church will be worldly, ecumenical, and global. It will be a loose federation of churches. And religions forming some type of global association. A world parliament of churches. It will be emptied of all divine content and will be the mystical body of the Antichrist. The mystical body on earth today will have its Judas Iscariot and he will be the false prophet. Satan will recruit him from among our bishops. There is a famous prophecy attributed to St. At the time of this tribulation a man, not authentically canonically elected, will be raised to the Pontificate, who, by his cunning, will endeavor to draw many into errorâ€¦ There will be such diversity of opinions and schisms among the peopleâ€¦ for in those days Jesus Christ will send them not a true Pastor, but a destroyer. The only way Pope Francis could fulfill this prophecy, if it is true, is if he personally held a secret heresy in his heart at his election. Then he would not have been validly canonically elected. I had another vision of the great tribulation. Evangelicals, Catholics, and all denominations, a true communion of the unholy with one shepherd and one flockâ€¦ I saw the fatal consequences of this counterfeit church: I saw it increase; I saw heretics of all kindsâ€¦ When the true Church had been for the most part destroyed, and when only the sanctuary and altar were still standing, I saw the wreckers enter the Church with the Beast antichrist â€¦ I see the Holy Father Benedict? He lives in a palace other than beforeâ€¦ I saw a strange church being built against every ruleâ€¦ the new heterodox Church of Romeâ€¦ Everything was being done, according to human reason. I saw all sorts of people, things, doctrines, and opinions. There was something proud, presumptuous, and violent about it, and they seemed to be very successfulâ€¦ The true Church is completely isolated and as if completely deserted. It seems that everyone is running away. Everywhere I see great misery, hatred, treason, rancor, confusion and utter blindness. What is threatening thee? The storm is coming, do be watchful! My Guide Jesus named Europe and pointing to a small and sandy region, He uttered these words: The day will come when the true Pope will be taken from his throneâ€¦ New Laws will be passed to impede the action of the churchâ€¦ In the great final battle, the smoke of the Devil will arise in the house of God, but the light of the Lord will prevailâ€¦ the lack of love for the truth and the disrespect for the sacraments will lead many of the consecrated to the abyss of apostasyâ€¦ The future of the Church will be marked with a great division and a sad religious dictatorship. Peter will encounter Judas in his wayâ€¦ Betrayal will touch the throne of Peterâ€¦ A decision will be made and there will be great confusion in the palace the Vatican â€¦ The future will be marked by divisions and scandals in the Church of my Jesusâ€¦ Treachery will touch the throne of Peterâ€¦ marked by a serious conflict between the true Church and the false one. Peter Peter the Roman will direct his barque amidst great tempests. The Barque of St. Peter is going to flounder, and there is going to be great confusionâ€¦ An apparently good and just man will appear. He will deceive many people, for he will realize great prodigies. His orders will be obeyed and what is precious will be thrown out. A great spiritual confusion is on the wayâ€¦ the one who could have been Peter will become Judas. He will open the doors for the enemy and will make men and women of faith sufferâ€¦ The church will be without Peterâ€¦ a war will explode on Rome and there will be few survivors. Listen to the true magisterium of the Church and flee from the lies of the devil. New ideas will arise, but the truth of my Jesus is in the Gospelâ€¦ Humanity will be surprised by a false prophet. Actions considered prodigious will fool many people. Love the truth and defend it. Those who remain faithful will experience great joy, for the Lord will come with His angels and the just will be protected. A great spiritual battle will occur and only those who are faithful will be able to support the weight of the cross. The day is coming when many will seek the banquet, but the table will be empty. There will be great persecution of the Church of my Jesus and my poor children will carry a heavy cross. Trust, and everything will end well for you. I Mary came from Heaven to prepare your victory. Follow my Son Jesus. Embrace the truth, for only in truth will you see the definitive triumph of my Immaculate Heart. Have courage, faith, and hope. In everything put God in first place. Peace be with you. The day will come that His Church will rise to the ordeal and the suffering will be great for men and women of faith. It will be a time of persecution, humiliation and

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abandonment. Greater pain did not exist. The enemies of God will unite and destroy temples in various parts and kill the faithful. Days of darkness will come to church, but when all seems lost The Lord will give to His Church to the great victory. A time of great tribulation for the Church has come. The Church will live moments of great affliction and faithful people will weep and lament. Bend your knees in prayer. I ask you to have the courage of John the Baptist. Defend without fear the true doctrine. Whatever happens do not allow the flame of your faith to be extinguished within you.
