Waynesville has been called the most haunted village in Ohio. The October tours conducted by volunteers of the Museum on three evenings a week explore historic downtown Waynesville or the Quaker Historic District. After the one hour tour, you can also take a self-guided tour of the Museum included in the price. Ghost themed dinners are also offered at the Hammel House Inn in October. Please have respect for not only the owners of the property, but also for any spirits left behind. If walking in a cemetery, please do not walk on the graves. This is considered a true sign of disrespect. Clearly this man was not respectful in the least. Our team is from Preble County Ohio which is in on the southern west side of the state. It was founded in Unfortunatly for Eaton residents as well as the rest of Preble County , in , a cholera epidemic struck the community. Approximately one-half of the residents fled the community. Many people do not know about this. There was so many dead that they had to start burying the bodies wherever they could. Many locals report strange activity. Sadly, this once beautiful land, has now been used as a dumping ground for local disrespecting people. There are tales of mass sightings of Native American ghosts that haunt the area. I have chosen to use info from the book "Preble County: Story goes there was a massacre there with many Native Americans getting killed. To insure that the graves were left undisturbed, legend says that ghost scouts were delegated to patrol the site. A hired hand by the name Elwood Davis, was actually convicted of his murder, but many locals still clung to the curse of Little Turtle being the true reason. Our team has tried to investigate this area a little during day light. While we were not able to catch any true evidence yet, there was a strange feeling of being watched. While we have no proof that this was indeed something paranormal, we hope to return for a more indepth investigation in the near future. Another legend about this area is that of Sasquatch. Sighting along Seven Mile Creek are still reported today. The fort was built in during the Northwest Territory Indian War It was built to to protect the area against Native American raids. Chris Woodyard has documented this park haunted in her book "Haunted Ohio". Our team has investigated this park a couple times now after dark Get permission before entering after dark as the park is closed at this time. Documented as a haunted location. Perhaps some are still lingering long after the smoke has settled. Perhaps some of these residents of old are still there, visiting with each other. Again, I have had personal experiences near this area. For 17 years I lived in a home not far from Sugar Valley. It was indeed haunted. At one point, while putting my shoes on for school, I felt someone sit down on my bed beside me. As I looked, you could see an indentation on the bed as if someone had sat down. The air felt cold there, not like the rest of the room which was a comfortable temperature. At times you could also feel "someone" watching you. Rumor was that there was a certain spot with a slight incline. We did find an area that not only had a slight incline, but did give a sensation of being pulled over it. Was it something paranormal, or just an optical illusion of an incline? We have found that something paranormal does appear to be there. Please always be respectful if investigating a cemetery. It is considered very disrespectful to walk on the graves. We also believe firmly in treating others dead or alive with the same respect that you would appreciate. For this reason it is our belief that provoking is not only dangerous, but a highly rude practice. Large white objects moving around, strange noises, and the feeling of being watched are common here. Police are often called to the area to investigate reports of strange lights and mysterious sounds. It is said the the area was cursed by Native Americans as they were being forced painfully from their home. The cemetery is surrounded by a 19th century dry- laid limestone fence. It is also said to bring bad luck to those who visit during the night. No proof has been documented. His land was aquired by the state of Ohio in The Adena Indians mound biulders also lived in this area in B. Milford Rd Located just outside of Oxford, the story goes that two forbidden lovers would meet up a certain driveway along Milford Road. One night as he began down the road, a young boy was riding his bicycle in the road. Both the boy and the boyfriend died. The girl later hang herself in the barn, of which, remnants remain. Helen Peabody, she is said to haunt the building. When near a window, men often report feeling a strong push towards the window. Women who are sick and trying to get out of bed feel themselves being pushed back into bed in a motherly manner. They both were of girls

hanging themselves. In other rooms, there have been times where window shades would flap frantically, but yet there was no wind present and no one would be near the window. Miami University-Wilson hall Once a tuberculosis hospital, it is said to be haunted by those who died there. Also that furniture moves around by itself. The tunnel was said to have collapsed and he was killed. It is also said that an electro-shock therapy tub is in the basement that used for insane patients. They say students have to pass this tub on their way to do laundry. He was known as the "Diamond Judge" because he always wore a diamond trinket around his neck. His ghost would steal things and write his initials using the bust created of him. He was an avid pipe smoker. Millville Cemetery Locals from Millville report seeing apparitions wandering the cemetery. One is said to be an elderly gentleman who roams around. Another is that of a young girl who stands next to a tree, looking into the field. People claim there is multiple hauntings along this stretch of road. Caution should be given when driving this road. Reily, OH Some say that all cemeteries in Reily are haunted. In one of the cemeteries, there is a statue of an angel with the arms missing. The angel was placed there by a grieving father to watch over his deceased child. The lights inside the restaurant often turn on and off by themselves at night. This would be next to the playground. Residents of the town have heard ghostly gunshots on winter nights. Hickory Flats Cemetery- Trenton Some claim that as you approach the cemetery on Wehr Road in Trenton Ohio, a man dressed in old dirty clothes will chase you away. The legend most often associated with the Cemetery is that the soldier died in a battle in southwest Ohio, and there was no time to move his body. Still another legend claims that the soldier was an Ohio native who joined the Confederate Army because he agreed with their side. After his death, his family requested that his body be buried in Ohio. He is said to wander the cemetery, looking lost and confused. Locals claim that the ghost of a former owner still walks around the mill. People have heard him walking upstairs, and heard the floorboards creaking as he walked. The legend is that a woman climbed to the top of it one night and committed suicide. Cox, founder of the Dayton Daily News is also buried in the Cemetery. Cox is buried on a small hill with only a plain headstone to mark his grave, while a large and elaborate mausoleum stands only a few feet away, unrelated to the Cox family. Author and humorist Erma Bombeck also calls Woodland her final resting place, with a 29, pound boulder her husband had shipped from Phoenix, where they lived part-time during their life together. While Woodland has its share of famous residents, some of its most famous residents refuse to allow being buried to stop them. Johnny Morehouse is one such resident. According to legend, Johnny drowned after falling into a local canal and after his burial, the dog still refused to leave his side. After his beloved pet died, a special marker was added to the headstone to commemorate his life. To this day people still leave behind candy and toys on the headstone, even over years after his death. During a visit there in August, we noticed a few stuffed animals, and dog toys left on the marker. Some also claim to hear barking coming from inside.
