For example, the message may be present if one or more applications or disk utilities that need to be uninstalled before upgrading. PCs seeing this error message will get instructions on how to fix this when they perform the upgrade. We recommend waiting until your PC receives a notification to upgrade and then following the instructions provided. To resolve this issue, open C: In the elevated command prompt window, type wuauclt. Wait 20 to 30 minutes for the computer to copy files. It will reboot several times. Click Next at the login screen. Click Use Express settings. You can always change some settings later. Click Next on the "New apps for the new Windows" screen. The computer will say "finalizing your settings," and then take you to the Windows 10 lock screen. Log in to your computer. Windows 10 will take another couple of minutes to do an initial setup and then it will take you to the Windows desktop. Having your own disk allows you to run the upgrade on multiple computers without waiting an hour for a fresh download. You also have the option of doing a clean install or running the upgrade a second time if you run into problems later. Before you begin, make sure to insert your flash drive into one of your USB ports. Be aware that all data on the drive will be erased. Follow steps 1 -3 above, installing the Download tool and launching it. Select "Create installation media. Select the language, edition and architecture 32 or 64 bits of Windows. Make sure your selections match those of the computer s you wish to upgrade. So, if you currently have Windows 8 Home bit , choose Windows 10 Home bit. Select USB flash drive. Click Finish when the process is complete. If you are in a big hurry, choose "Not right now. If the software asks you for a product key, you are using the wrong version of Windows 10 to upgrade.
