Letters may also have numerical value. This is true of Roman numerals and the letters of other writing systems. In English Arabic numerals are typically used instead of letters. Mostly, though, they scribble notes and leave them somewhere unlikely, for somebody to find. It also sounds, well, a bit American touchy-feely. Even if his notes were printouts and not charmingly done by hand. But I know that if I was on the receiving end of a letter like that, it almost certainly might put a smile on my face. So I decide to give it a try and see if I might do the same for someone else. On the morning I decide to write my love letters to strangers, I realise I have committed that journalist schoolgirl-error of forgetting my notepad and pen. So I trundle off to the nearest Paperchase and select some tiny squares of pale-grey card with matching little envelopes.
