

Chapter 1 : Lemhi County, Idaho - Wikipedia

Established January 9, with its county seat at Salmon. Named for Fort Lemhi, the L.D.S. Salmon River Mission, which was named for King Lemhi in the book of Mormon. Lewis and Clark were the first white men in this area.

Early natives were spear hunters of big game. The Salmon River was the dividing point among the first cultural split which occurred after 5, BC. The Lemhi band of Shoshoni developed culturally in similar fashion to other Shoshoni tribes located south of and east of the Salmon River. They were also known as "Salmon Eaters". Their migratory pattern consisted of fishing for Salmon in the Lemhi Valley in the summer, digging Camas on Camas Creek in the spring, and hunting buffalo in the Three Forks area of the Missouri River. They were also known to travel to trade with other tribes. The Lemhi band was forced to a reservation on 12 February, even though the tribe failed to ratify the treaty creating it in 1855. The reservation was disbanded in 1863 and the tribe sent to Fort Hall. Meriwether Lewis and three other members of the expedition were the first Americans to enter what is now Idaho. For Sacajawea, their guide and interpreter, the Lemhi Valley was her birthplace and her brother was the Chief of the Lemhi band. The region would support trapping operations for about 20 years. Mormon settlers established Fort Lemhi from 1842 to 1843. The settlement was withdrawn after a native attack on the settlement. The first gold miners ventured into Lemhi County starting in 1862, with miners working the main Salmon River all the way from Salmon down to Slate Creek. Sharkey and his party struck gold at Leesburg on July 16, 1862. The rush to Leesburg ensued within a month. Additional discovery of gold occurred at Lemhi in 1863 and Shoup in 1864. Salmon City became the county seat of Lemhi County when it was formed in 1864. Additional mining operations occurred at Yellow Jacket in 1865, Gibbonsville in 1866, Gilmore in 1867, Blackbird in 1868, and Leadore in 1869. The railroad was built to access ore from Gilmore. The railroad ceased operations in 1870. While Salmon has gone by the name of Salmon City since its inception, it did not have legal status as a city until around 1870. Patterson was dis-incorporated by 1870. Boise County was created in 1870 with its northern boundary running just north of the ridge dividing Birch Creek from the Lemhi River. The first occasion was on December 21, 1870. A county government was organized at Salmon City, yet the bill approving the county was misplaced and never published in session laws. The following session, the legislature passed the bill again, officially creating Lemhi County on January 9, 1871. The county government was reorganized at Salmon City on February 22, 1871. Finalization of the southern boundary came in several steps from 1871 to 1875. In 1871, the boundary was moved southward, gaining territory in present Clark County, creating a contiguous boundary, and leaving a 6 mile by 9 mile portion of that territory. The eastern 6 mile by 9 mile portion of that territory was transferred from Alturas to Bingham in 1872. A change in 1873 extended the boundary south to its present location, and added territory presently in Clark County. With legislative approval, voters in that territory voted to become part of Fremont County in 1874, finalizing the southern and eastern boundary. The boundary was moved westward to the divide between the Payette and Salmon Rivers in 1875, moved eastward to a line drawn through the confluence of the Middle Fork and main Salmon rivers in 1876, and then mistakenly extended to the northern line of Idaho County in 1877 before being finalized at its present location in 1878. Custer County was partitioned from Lemhi in 1878 with its initial boundary excluding the Loon Creek area. The Loon Creek area was transferred back to Idaho County in 1879.

The assessment notice provides information about further appeals procedures. Each of the other four years of the cycle, the law requires that a market adjustment be applied to the property, based on the selling prices of similar properties, to keep the property value in line with market trends. Idaho law requires that appointments for protests be made on or before the fourth Monday in June. This procedure is known as placing market value on property. All property is assessed as of January 1 each year using sales or property occurring between January 1 and December 31 of the previous year. If too few or no sales are available, the assessor can use sales from other time periods, or from similar areas. This process demonstrates that the subject property is valued according to market sales. To achieve a meaningful and productive appeal, the property owner should supply evidence that establishes error in the appraisal of the property. It is important to employ comparables from the same location as the subject and to consider age, type and condition. It is essential to understand the definition of typical when supplying information to the assessor. When several comparable properties sell, the assessor applies the average or typical values gathered from such data in determining the assessment instead of picking the highest or lowest values. There are methods available to protest taxes. Property taxes are used by schools, local government and other taxing districts. Concerned taxpayers should protest spending by attending the annual budget hearings of each taxing district affecting them. Budget hearings are open to the public and offer invitation to anyone with comments. Make personal contact with elected officials who authorize and control spending i. Voicing concern with elected officials will influence spending and the efficiency of the departments they direct.

In addition to the above requirements, and the requirement of one parent for each year-old, a person under 16 years of age must have an appointment with the Magistrate Judge to obtain a court order permitting the year-old to be married. No waiting period or blood tests are required. Two copies of the marriage license are issued. One copy is for the couple and one copy is to be sent in for recording by the person performing the ceremony.
