During polygraphs, border agency applicants admit to rape, kidnapping Andrew Becker Border and National Security Reporter Jose Ramirez, 25, admitted during a pre-employment polygraph screening that he was the driver in a single-car crash in Arizona that killed a passenger. Ramirez now faces second-degree murder and other charges. One admitted to kidnapping and ransoming hostages in the Ivory Coast. Others said they had molested children or committed rape. And one, as he prepared for survival in a post-apocalyptic world, contemplated assassinating President Barack Obama. These are among the thousands of applicants who have sought sensitive law enforcement jobs in recent years with the U. Border Patrol and its parent agency, Customs and Border Protection. In many cases, these people made it all the way through the hiring process until one of the last steps — a polygraph exam. Once sitting with a polygraph examiner, they admitted to a host of astonishing crimes, according to documents obtained by the Center for Investigative Reporting. The records — official summaries of more than polygraph admissions — raise alarms about the thousands of employees Customs and Border Protection has hired over the past six years before it began mandatory polygraph tests for all applicants six months ago. The required polygraphs come at the tail end of a massive hiring surge that began in and eventually added 17, employees, helping to make the agency the largest law enforcement operation in the country. Although thousands of applicants have undergone polygraphs, thousands more have been hired without the screening. And they spur the question: Why would anyone share their deepest, darkest secrets for a job? And it eats away at them. They also highlight potential weaknesses in the costly hiring process that failed to screen out questionable applicants earlier. In one case from February, Jose Ramirez, 25, admitted during a polygraph exam that he was the driver in a single-car crash that killed someone. He previously told investigators in Yuma, Ariz. One applicant admitted to smoking marijuana 20, times in a year-period. Another was more bizarre: In another example, a woman seeking a job with the bureau told an examiner that she smuggled marijuana into the country — typically by taping 10 pounds of the drug to her body — about times. Scores more admitted that they had engaged in or had relatives involved in human smuggling or drug running. Some said they harbored immigrants not authorized to be in the U. The summaries disclose dozens of attempts to infiltrate the agency, including 10 applicants believed to have links to organized crime who had received sophisticated training on how to defeat the polygraph exam, according to Customs and Border Protection. The agency declined multiple interview requests about its polygraph program. In a written statement, spokesman Michael J. Friel said the bureau has a rigorous application process, which includes an initial screening, a background investigation of prospective employees and the polygraph exam. The agency said since it began administering polygraphs in , more than 15, people have taken the test, and 60 percent were not cleared. It took almost five years, however, for Customs and Border Protection to require all applicants to take a polygraph. In that time, the agency continued to hire potentially flawed candidates. The number of employees busted for corruption and misconduct is a fraction of the more than 60, employed by the bureau. But misconduct allegations have been on the rise, including a 62 percent jump from to , according to a recent Government Accountability Office report. But a polygraph examiner learned about it just a few weeks after the bureau started the program. A combat-tested Marine with a security clearance, Montross, then 28, seemed like an ideal candidate. Montross consented to a search of the Houston home he shared with his parents and three younger half siblings, according to his plea agreement. Investigators later found more than 9, images and videos of child pornography, the court record shows. He also admitted to producing child pornography. Montross was sentenced to 30 years in federal prison and a lifetime of supervised release. Several divulged that they possessed classified information. Other people admitted they had sought out a contract killer or took money to kill someone. Just like a city of that size, you have people who have problems, make mistakes and break laws. They ask a range of questions that start innocuous and become more threatening. After the exam, they often invite applicants to unload any mental burdens they might be carrying. The polygraph exams are recorded, and applicants sign a consent form that allows admissions to be shared

with other law enforcement agencies. The customs agency has not made public how many cases have been forwarded for further investigation or prosecution or how many have led to convictions. Some applicants who confess to or admit they know about crimes might become informants, or a prosecutor ultimately might choose to not pursue a case. When interviewed by a detective, Slaughter admitted to the sexual assault, as well as sexual contact numerous times with his horse, a dog and once with a 4-H pig, according to a police report. Before the hiring surge began in, misconduct arrests for offenses like drunken driving fluctuated. A total of 2, reported incidents of employees arrested occurred between Oct. In most of the roughly cases, the polygraph detected a response to a question that alarmed the polygrapher or the applicant made an unsuitable admission during the exam. At that point in time, fewer than 20 percent of applicants were asked to take a polygraph exam, usually because of outstanding questions after the background investigation. Concerned that Customs and Border Protection was under siege from infiltrators attempting to take jobs, Congress in made polygraphs mandatory for all prospective hires seeking law enforcement posts. Customs and Border Protection beat its deadline by a few months, reaching percent of all applicants in October. In June, the agency began administering the polygraph exam before a full background investigation to cut costs and more aggressively weed out applicants. Internal affairs officials have considered requiring polygraphs for current employees. But such a move, which would have to be approved by the U.

As with my other research, I used simple Twitter and Google searches to locate mainstream media reports of military staff arrested on child pornography charges. This is by no means a comprehensive account. The data does provide a sense of the scale of the trade in child rape within our military; one that represents a serious security issue not only for military children but for all Americans. Comprehensive data collection on this subject is urgently needed. Arrests A few examples of military arrests include: Steven Jon Frederiksen, Defense Intelligence Agency DIA employee, was sentenced, 8 November , to 20 years in prison with 20 years of supervised release for producing child pornography. He pled guilty to one count of producing child pornography and one count of attempted coercion and enticement of a minor. He was also trading in the rape of prepubescent children from his government computer. Frederiksen is a West Point graduate. He joined the Army in and was a Boy Scout and church youth leader. Robert Joel Rice Col. After many delays, Rice was sentenced, 28 December , to 12 years in federal prison followed by 10 years of supervised released concurrent with a four-year prison sentence from a military court-martial in October The Army War College continued to employ Rice, while he was free on bail, and allowed him supervised access to Army computers pending sentencing. His wife had discovered these and notified police. The man who was monitoring global nuclear activity for the security of our country was trading in child rape, including from Russian sources, from his Air Force computer. The military has the technical capacity to block child pornography. Blocking programs are an easy technical fix. Iceland, for example, has been considering a nation-wide block on adult and child pornography. This is a choice. The military, like other government agencies, is not gathering and making public comprehensive data on child pornography arrests. They should be required to do so. Child sex abuse allegations are probable cause for child pornography investigations and vice versa. These investigations must be coordinated in the military. Robust and comprehensive child protection procedures must become the norm in all military investigations. Child pornography must be blocked from all military computers and regular random searches of military electronics, including personal electronic devices for those with top security clearance, must be a top priority. While there are many dedicated law enforcement officers LEOs for whom I have tremendous respect, especially those investigating child pornography, the arrests of law enforcement engaged in this crime are alarming and appear to be widespread. How many state and local enforcement officers have been arrested on child pornography related charges? No one knows " because law enforcement has not been collecting the data. While there is a National Decertification Index NDI listing officers who have lost certification, this is voluntary, and many agencies simply choose not to share information. In addition, the NDI database does not provide information on offense type. Arrests Similar to the military, many arrested police were in leadership positions, including ten captains or chiefs, and were often trading in infant and toddler rape. Officer Michael Harding, of Port St. Lucie, Florida, was arrested September , on child pornography charges. He was caught in a chatroom called toddlerfuck. He was discovered by federal investigators discussing raping and killing young boys. Demers was sentenced to five years, one of which was suspended. He served 26 years with the Maine State Police and was chief from to Gilberto Valle, a year-old New York City police officer whose online name was Girlmeat Hunter was convicted, March , of conspiracy to kidnap and illegal access of a federal government database. Valle engaged in online arrangements with a man who offered his three-year-old stepdaughter as a sex slave and his two nieces, age seven and nine, for rape. Valle also discussed plans to murder his wife, saying he would tie up her feet, slit her throat and watch the blood rush from her body. She gave the computer to the FBI and fled the state with their one-year-old baby. Judge Paul Gardephe overturned a conviction, gave Valle a misdemeanor and released him on time-served, twenty-one months, and one year supervised release. Valle said he plans to become a criminal defense attorney and pursue custody rights of his 3-year-old daughter. He also hopes to return to the New York Police Department. No police officer, who has sworn an oath to serve and protect, should ever be engaged in the trade in child rape. Deeply concerning is the brutal rape and violence of infants and toddlers, that so many police have been caught producing and trading. How can any parent have faith that their families and children will be protected by local and state law enforcement, knowing how many police are participating in the crime? Postal Inspectors, employing, according to the most recent U. Bureau of Justice Statistics BJS data, some , full-time law enforcement officers LEOs with the legal authority to make arrests and carry firearms. Like all other government agencies, there is no comprehensive data available on how many federal LEOs have been arrested on child pornography charges. If you believe the U. Aliya Sternstein, a journalist with The Christian Science Monitor, attempted to gather child pornography related arrests of federal government employees, including federal law enforcement. Postal System USPS is one of the best federal law enforcement agencies investigating child pornography crimes. After months of protracted discussions with management at both agencies, the DEA and FBI provided the information without extensive redactions; but we found that the information was still incomplete. Ultimately, based on a review of information in the OIG Investigations Division databases, we determined that a material number of allegations from both DEA and FBI were not included in the original responses to our request for the information. We were also concerned by an apparent decision by DEA to withhold information regarding a particular open misconduct case. The OIG

was not given access to this case file information until several months after our request, and only after the misconduct case was closed. Once we became aware of the information, we interviewed DEA employees who said that they were given the impression that they were not to discuss this case with the OIG while the case remained open. The OIG was entitled to receive all such information from the outset, and the failure to provide it unnecessarily delayed our work. Therefore, we cannot be completely confident that the FBI and DEA provided us with all information relevant to this review. As a result, our report reflects the findings and conclusions we reached based on the information made available to us. Over half, cases, were in the FBI. Marshals provided two reports. Therefore, the reported cases likely represent a small percentage of overall engagement in the crime. Many, if not most, pedophiles are apprehended because of a mistake they make rather than routine monitoring and oversight. When federal law enforcement agencies refuse to comply with legal requests from the OIG, it is nearly impossible for an unfunded researcher, like myself, to obtain comprehensive statistics. In order to acquire data on child pornography arrests for all 73 federal agencies, I would need to obtain Inspector General reports for every agency over a ten-year period, file multiple freedom of information act requests and purchase and analyze over 20, federal prosecution records.

Fourteen years later he fought alongside Robb Stark during the War of the Five Kings, but after conspiring with Walder Frey and Tywin Lannister to orchestrate the infamous event known as the Red Wedding that resulted in the death of both Robb and his mother Catelyn, he becomes the new Warden of the North, while his son, Ramsay, becomes the new Lord of Winterfell. He receives regular leechings, which he believes to improve his health, prompting some to call him "The Leech Lord". Roose Bolton practices the abolished and now illegal tradition of the First Night privilege. He is however extremely discreet with his activities in order to avoid the attention and possible ire of House Stark. The moment Roose saw her, he desired her. Although he did not believe her at first, he saw that the boy had his eyes and thus paid the woman to raise Ramsay. Although he ordered her never to reveal his true parentage to Ramsay, Ramsay eventually found out. Roose and his second wife, Bethany, had one child, Domeric Bolton. Eventually, Bethany died of sickness. Robb wants to free his father and decides to aid his grandfather Hoster Tully in the war against the Lannisters in the Riverlands. He answers by calling all the bannermen of the north, including Roose of the Dreadfort, who brings his own army to Winterfell. They are joined by the other houses until Catelyn meets them at Moat Cailin with the Manderly army. During the march, the war in the Riverlands has already started and Lord Tywin Lannister is defeating the river lords and invading various castles and cities, while Ser Jaime Lannister defeated Ser Edmure Tully and his army at the walls of Riverrun. Now Robb has to make a choice: The Lannisters are blocking the kingsroad, but House Frey is still neutral and fought westermen outriders. Ser Helman Tallhart commands a northern garrison at the Twins, making sure that Walder does not betray Robb. Roose commands a host consisting of all the northern foot and some of the horse. Roose travels south along the east bank of the Trident to distract Tywin. He marches through the night and launches a surprise attack in the early morning, but is defeated by Tywin in the battle on the Green Fork, in which his men fail to kill Ser Gregor Clegane. Lord Hornwood is slain and many of the Northmen and Freys are captured, including Harrion Karstark and Lord Cerwyn, who later dies of his wounds at Harrenhal. However, Roose retreats in good order, reforming the battered remnants of his army on the causeway before Moat Cailin. Roose becomes a close ally to Lord Walder and later commands Ser Helman and his men to leave the Twins, likely to avoid them to report anything to Robb in case the war goes in his disfavor. Robb stays at Riverrun for a while and tries to make failed alliances with the kings Balon Greyjoy and Renly Baratheon. Because Ser Stafford Lannister is leading another huge host from Casterly Rock, Robb and his men ride to the westerlands to fight them. Meanwhile, Roose serves as the commander of the northern army who fights in the Riverlands in support of the Tullys while Robb invades the westerlands. His second in command is Robett Glover. After defeating the Lannisters at Oxcross, Robb decides to stay to raid the westerlands, taking castles, towns, mines, and cattle. During the war, the Lannisters ransom some captives to Roose, including Freys. Roose does not mourn Ramsay at all and hopes that Walda will give him a new male heir soon. But the Starks are winning their war and there are tensions between the Lannister garrison at Harrenhal and the Bloody Mummies. Bolton makes the girl Nymeria Arya Stark his cupbearer. Roose and Vargo kill the castellan Ser Amory Lorch and start liberating

settlements invaded by Lannister garrisons in the Riverlands. The westermen are easily defeated thanks to the surprise attacks from the traitor sellswords. The invasions of Moat Cailin and Winterfell are what truly distract the northern army from their cause in the south, now following a boy without a seat and a kingdom. But they are convinced Stark supporters and all of them want to execute the traitor Theon Greyjoy for the murder of the Stark boys, Bran and Rickon. This causes desperation to both Robb and Catelyn, the former marrying the highborn Jeyne Westerling after having sex with her in his grief, the latter getting drunk and freeing Jaime Lannister from the dungeons of Riverrun. Both Catelyn and Jaime are drunk when Jaime promises to bring back her daughters. When the men in the north assemble a new army to besiege Winterfell, Ramsay rides back to the Dreadfort to assemble a Bolton force for Winterfell. Roose is interested in this and begins to notice that Robb may be incapable of winning the war, causing him to later betray him. Lord Walder sends a letter at Harrenhal, informing his family about Robb breaking his sacred marriage vow, thus ending the Stark-Frey alliance and the betrothals with Robb and Arya. After Castle Darry is liberated, Roose sends Robett Glover, Ser Helman Tallhart, and Harrion Karstark to lead a huge portion of the northern army to its own destruction in the Battle at Duskendale, where they are later defeated in that city by Lord Randyll Tarly and shortly after, Glover and his survivors are chased and captured by Ser Gregor Clegane. After seeing how Roose had many servants of Harrenhal put to the sword, including the maester, Arya decided that she found Bolton too scary and planned to reveal her identity to Robett Glover, but before she could see him, the Northman had already left Harrenhal. During the escape, Arya kills a Bolton man-at-arms, which causes Roose to send a party of Brave Companions to chase them, but they are killed by the dire wolf Nymeria and her pack of wolves. Soon, unrelenting heavy rains keep falling in the west, with huge storms in the Iron Islands, which make the raging rivers almost impossible to cross. At the ruby ford of the Trident, Roose and his Bolton men and some Karstarks cross the Trident on boats before any other Northmen serving under other houses. As Roose reaches safely the other side of the river, the rest of his force, led by Ser Wylis Manderly is still waiting to cross. The surviving free northerners flee and disperse in the rainy lands, while the Cleganes take control of the Trident. These men are left behind and apparently, it seems that Roose let the Mountain attack his army, so that more Stark loyalists could die. Of course, Bolton makes no mention of himself giving the command and states that Robett did it in his own grief for his wife and children at Deepwood Motte with the ironborn. Roose repeats the "official" events of the battle and sack of Winterfell that Lothar Frey told Robb back at Riverrun: Theon and his men attacked and killed the northern army, including Ser Rodrik Cassel, Lord Cley Cerwyn, and Leobald Tallhart, then proceeded to attack Winterfell and the winter town, but Ramsay has heroically led the women and children to the Dreadfort. Roose stays cold and reacts indifferently from the perspective of losing another son. After Edmure and Roslin leave the great hall for their wedding night, Lord Walder betrays the Northmen and his fellow rivermen by massacring them in what becomes known as the Red Wedding. As fightings and burnings are taking place in the camps outside the Crossing, the massacre in the great hall is nearly finished, and Roose stabs Robb in the chest with a sword a dagger in the TV series, killing him. They receive news that he has executed Mance Rayder, the King-beyond-the-Wall. The plan fails as Stannis marches to the northern mountains and plans to gain support from the north instead. The Northmen and the crannogmen destroy the sick ironmen and their ships on the Fever River. The siege ends when Theon convinces Adrack Humble to surrender, resulting in the last men being flayed alive by Ramsay and his men. Roose thinks that Ramsay is too loud and obnoxious. With the help of Petyr Baelish, Sansa becomes engaged to Ramsay. After Roose hears that Stannis Baratheon has retaken Deepwood Motte, he decides that they need to leave Barrowton

quickly. He is accompanied by his new wife, Walda. Roose tells Ramsay that Stannis is marching his way to Winterfell in order to take the North. Both Roose and Ramsay plan to fight against him. So, Roose immediately rallies his bannermen and the Freys in his army to march on Winterfell and prepare for a siege in a kingdom invaded by a royal army, wildlings, ironmen, and northern rebels. Upon arriving at Winterfell, Roose finds the ruined castle now a refuge of more than two dozen squatters. When he tells them he will be merciful if they serve well, they are used for a labor force in rebuilding Winterfell. After the work is completed, Roose has them hanged instead of flayed, which Theon considers merciful. At Winterfell, Ramsay marries Arya Stark and Roose hopes this will help to hold a lawful claim of the north, with the last living Stark. Many other northern lords and their armies arrive at Winterfell for the wedding and the looming siege. During the wedding feast, Roose does not eat any of the food or drink served to him unless he sees Lord Wyman Manderly, who brought the food, eat of the same dish. Wyman is particularly pleased by the pies made with pieces of dead Freys. At Deepwood Motte with the Mormonts and other northern houses, Stannis decides to save Arya and during the march to Winterfell is joined by numerous northern rebel houses. During the wedding agents of Melisandre infiltrated Winterfell and in the following weeks, they start creating chaos in the castle by murdering people and fueling tensions between the Northmen and the Freys about the events of the Red Wedding, eventually culminating with a fight between the Freys and the Manderlys. Arnolf Karstark, who publicly declared for Stannis, is secretly in league with Roose and awaits the moment to turn his cloak. The Northmen with Stannis agree with this idea, stating that the Lord of Light will only bring doom. The people of Winterfell and the winter town are paralyzed in fear of the upcoming siege from the despised king, the fog and the dark sky make it impossible to scout ahead or tell when Stannis will attack.
