Practice Policies Co-payments and insurance deductibles Copayments and insurance deductibles represent the portion of our services that patients must pay out of pocket. No waivers can be allowed. For Medicare, law requires collection of deductibles and co-payments, and waiver of such payments constitutes fraud. To comply with our contracts, AARA requires payment in full at the time of services including any co-payments and deductibles. Any payment past due must be made before the next scheduled visit can proceed. This means that if you have not paid your prior co-payment or deductible, your visit may be rescheduled until payment is made. No Shows and Late Cancellations In an effort to serve our patients and the community well, we must utilize our time efficiently. When a patient makes an appointment, time is set aside for their needs, and work is performed to prepare their record for the visit. When a scheduled visit is not completed, there is a loss for another patient who could have used that available time, as well as wasted staff time. Therefore, we ask that when a scheduled visit cannot be met, it be cancelled at least twenty-four hours prior to the time of the appointment. In most practices, waiting times for a new patient to see a rheumatologist is 2 to 6 months, and many rheumatologists struggle to meet the needs for follow-up care of existing patients. The shortage is projected to worsen over the next 20 years. Therefore, as a policy at AARA, patients are discouraged from insisting on seeing only the physician on the team as this may result in delays and inefficiency in scheduling and needed care. If you have a preference for a particular physician at AARA, you must tell us when scheduling the first visit. Every reasonable attempt will be made to accommodate your preference. An exception to this policy often occurs if the patient has moved to a new geographical area making such a switch most reasonable for all concerned. Civility At AARA, we chose to live and work in a culture of service supported by an atmosphere of mutual respect, human dignity, patience, and civility. The expression of these values is expected consistently from everyone including staff, physicians, patients and their families. Failures by our staff to follow this policy will result in corrective action and potential discharge from employment. The authority to prescribe such medicines is a privilege granted by agencies including the Drug Enforcement Agency DEA that regulate their use, and scrutinize prescribing practices. Abrogation of the agreement may result in interruption or discontinuation of such medications and possible withdrawal from medical care.
