After all, when was the last time a truly innovative retail experience hit the market? Specialty players have been amazingly laggard for inexplicable reasons and with few exceptions. Shocking shoppers with half-nude models and noxious fragrance, blasting club music into mall atriums? It might not have been an experience for all or arguably one that would work today, but it was an edgy concept that worked amazingly well at the time. Chances like that created a very distinct brand identity that carried for over 20 years. What specialty retailer is taking a similar creative leap of faith today? Amazon is an unbeatable data machine. But the data, no matter how voluminous, is never going to beat a groundbreaking creative concept. The inventive will live forever in an exclusive world.
