What Is a Vision Statement? Although the individual details and focus vary, all effective vision statements encapsulate the core ideals that give a business its shape and direction and provide a roadmap to where it wants to go. This will prevent the process from becoming merely an intellectual exercise, said Shockley. It is pointless to hang a vision statement in the office lobby or promote it on social media if it never is truly integrated into the company culture. You want your entire team and organization to be able to quickly repeat it and, more importantly, understand it, said Falkowski. However, a vision statement needs to be more than a catchy tagline. You can start by mapping out the most audacious goals your business hopes to achieve, Taylor suggested. Your answers to these inquiries will help you shape your vision statement. Work on shaping a vision statement that reflects the specific nature of your business and its aspirations. Shockley said there is nothing wrong with a vision statement being a little daring, distinct or even disagreeable. It will help inform direction and set priorities while challenging employees to grow. But most importantly, a vision statement must be compelling not just to the high-level executives of your company, but to all employees. Project five to 10 years in the future. Dream big and focus on success. Use the present tense. Use clear, concise and jargon-free language. Infuse it with passion and emotion. Align it with your business values and goals. Have a plan to communicate your vision statement to your employees. Be prepared to commit time and resources to the vision you establish.
