Sendak, as a child, had observed his relatives as being "all crazy â€” crazy faces and wild eyes", with blood-stained eyes and "big and yellow" teeth, who pinched his cheeks until they were red. As a child, however, he saw them only as "grotesques". Tzippy, Moishe, Aaron, Emile, and Bernard.
