

Chapter 1 : The Third Day () - IMDb

These last twenty-five years of THIRD DAY have been an amazing ride that we never in our wildest dreams thought we would experience. We know this is a season that is coming to a close, and we wanted to give our fans one more chance to see us perform live.

On the Third Day He Rose from the Dead "We bring you the good news that what God promised to the fathers, this day he has fulfilled to us their children by raising Jesus. Christ is risen from the dead! Dying, he conquered death; To the dead, he has given life. Paul could already write to the Corinthians: He is not here, but has risen. Its discovery by the disciples was the first step toward recognizing the very fact of the Resurrection. This was the case, first with the holy women, and then with Peter. Peter had been called to strengthen the faith of his brothers, and so sees the Risen One before them; it is on the basis of his testimony that the community exclaims: As witnesses of the Risen One, they remain the foundation stones of his Church. The faith of the first community of believers is based on the witness of concrete men known to the Christians and for the most part still living among them. Peter and the Twelve are the primary "witnesses to his Resurrection", but they are not the only ones - Paul speaks clearly of more than five hundred persons to whom Jesus appeared on a single occasion and also of James and of all the apostles. Far from showing us a community seized by a mystical exaltation, the Gospels present us with disciples demoralized "looking sad" and frightened. For they had not believed the holy women returning from the tomb and had regarded their words as an "idle tale". On the contrary their faith in the Resurrection was born, under the action of divine grace, from their direct experience of the reality of the risen Jesus. He invites them in this way to recognize that he is not a ghost and above all to verify that the risen body in which he appears to them is the same body that had been tortured and crucified, for it still bears the traces of his Passion. At some particular moment they would die again. In his risen body he passes from the state of death to another life beyond time and space. Paul can say that Christ is "the man of heaven". No one can say how it came about physically. Still less was its innermost essence, his passing over to another life, perceptible to the senses. This is why the risen Christ does not reveal himself to the world, but to his disciples, "to those who came up with him from Galilee to Jerusalem, who are now his witnesses to the people. In it the three divine persons act together as one, and manifest their own proper characteristics. Jesus is conclusively revealed as "Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness by his Resurrection from the dead". Jesus announces that the Son of man will have to suffer much, die, and then rise. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. For as death is produced by the separation of the human components, so Resurrection is achieved by the union of the two. All truths, even those most inaccessible to human reason, find their justification if Christ by his Resurrection has given the definitive proof of his divine authority, which he had promised. Paul could declare to the Jews: For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive. In Christ, Christians "have tasted. They prepared the disciples to encounter the Risen Lord.

Many Christians use the term to indicate a belief in Jesus. On the contrary, Christian faith is not simply a belief in Christ Jesus as our Savior. So what does it mean to truly have faith? It is a process that requires cultivation on our part. We do not automatically gain this type of faith by mindlessly attending church. Outside of attending church, how many of them are reading the Bible on a regular basis and working towards bolstering their relationship with God? God creates us in His image Genesis 1: As an infant grows, she learns to roll over, sit up on her own, crawl, and then walk. Similarly as our faith matures, we go through different phases. In the first phase, we are the oppressed Israelites in Egypt. While in this phase, we approach God through the law of conscience because God set eternity in our hearts Ecclesiastes 3: We embark on our spiritual journey by metaphorically crossing over the Red Sea and entering the wilderness church or second phase of faith. In the second phase, our conscience seeks God through institutions like the organized churches. The Israelites spent forty years in the wilderness before making it to Canaan. This is an extraordinarily long time considering the short distance they had to traverse. While in the wilderness, they encountered venomous snakes and scorpions Deuteronomy 8: Take note, venomous snakes and scorpions represent the teachings of men. After we spend sufficient time in the wilderness, we too are able to figuratively cross the Jordan River to enter the third phase of faith. Later on in the fourth phase, we approach God through the Spirit of Truth and our spirit is revived. We can only enter the Promised Land when our spirit is revived. When we are in the wilderness church, we are called out of Egypt, but we have not received salvation yet. In this state we easily vacillate between worldly knowledge and the Word of Truth because we are unable to fully distinguish between the two. Many in the wilderness church believe they have salvation. Unfortunately those in the wilderness church worship Jesus without truly knowing the inner meaning of Christ Jesus. The teachings we learned in the wilderness church are the elementary Hebrews 6: In the wilderness, Christians gain the teachings of men and interpret the written word with human wisdom, which causes them to linger in the second phase of faith. When Jesus speaks of the religious leaders in the four books of the Gospel, He speaks of the bondage of the wilderness church Matthew 23 , Mark 8: The goal of our faith should be to reach for and attain the third day faith. This is significant because it represents when our spirit is revived and God restores us. Those who accept Jesus as Savior with their conscience are blessed even if they remain in the wilderness church, as long as they are reaching for the third day faith. Still, we must not linger in the wilderness church. The days of the creation story represent yet another way to understand how our faith grows with Christ. After God dried the land on restores. He commanded seed-bearing plants and trees to produce vegetation on the dry ground Genesis 1: Dry ground referred our inner states. We too must plant seeds in our dry land. These seeds are the Word of God Luke 8: The seeds sown in good soil will surely grow and bear fruit. This is the meaning of the third day. We are still in the second phase of faith when this occurs. As with all seeds that are planted in good soil, sprouts eventually emerge. The same will happen when the Word of God is planted in our flesh. The discerned Word comes to us individually. This is the resurrection of Christ Jesus in our spirits. Until we achieve this state, we have a reputation of being alive, but we are dead Revelation 3: With the fourth phase of faith we approach God through the Spirit of Truth. Once we reached the fourth phase we simultaneously work toward encompassing the fourth, fifth, and sixth days of the creation story.

In Scripture the number three signifies completeness or perfection and points to what is solid, real, and substantial. As a number which indicates completeness, the number three always identifies some important event in Salvation History. In the Old Testament: It is the first of the four so called perfect numbers: The earth was separated from the waters on the 3rd day. There are 3 Patriarchs: After the Great Flood mankind descended from the 3 sons of Noah: Shem, Ham, and Japheth. Abraham was commanded to sacrifice his son after a 3-day journey to Mt. Baby Moses was hidden by his mother for 3 months Exodus 2: There were 3 divisions of the desert Tabernacle and later the Temple in Jerusalem: The Theophany at Sinai was on the 3rd day after the people arrived. God is mentioned 3 times in the Shema the first profession of faith in Deuteronomy 6: There are 3 attributes of God mentioned in Exodus Of the 7 Holy Feasts of the Sinai Covenant, 3 are pilgrim feasts in which every man 13 years or older must present himself before God at the Temple in Jerusalem Exodus Jonah spent 3 days in the belly of the great fish Jonah 1: Mary stayed with Elizabeth about 3 months Luke 1: Jesus was missing for 3 days when He was twelve years old Luke 2: Jesus took 3 men, Peter, James and John, up on the Mt. Jesus prophesized that He would arise from the dead on the 3rd day Matthew Saul was blinded for 3 days Acts 9: There are 3 theological virtues: The heavenly Jerusalem has 3 gates on each of its four sides Revelation Father, Son, and Holy Spirit Matthew In the symbolic language of the Bible, a three day period points to an act of divine intervention which impacts Salvation History. Moriah to offer his son in sacrifice, as commanded by Yahweh, was a three day journey. In the Gospels Jesus often spoke of a three day period prophesying His sacrifice and resurrection. For example, in Genesis chapter 22, in the significant event which the Jews call the Akeidah, the "binding of Isaac," Yahweh tells Abraham to take his son Isaac to the land of Moriah where he is to offer his son in sacrifice Genesis It happened some time later that God put Abraham to the test. He chopped wood for the burnt offering and started on his journey to the place which Gods had indicated to him. On the third day Abraham looked up and saw the place in the distance. It is On the third day that Abraham arrived and saw the place in the distance. Instead of permitting the sacrifice of Isaac, God intervenes and commands Abraham to sacrifice a ram in the place of his son. Isaac is redeemed, and he who was as good as dead was raised up and restored to his father on the third day. Sometimes this symbolic expression for divine intervention and restoration after a time of trial is expressed as "on the third day" and at other times as "after three days. Another reference to restoration on the third day is found in Hosea 6: After two days he will revive us; on the third day he will raise us up, that we may live before him.
