Teacher of The Chakras: Chakra is a Sanskrit word literally meaning wheel or circle. The chakras are a part of what might be called our spiritual anatomy. Just as there is an anatomy to the physical body and maps to the physical world, so also there is a definite anatomy of our spiritual beings, as well as maps and guideposts to follow along the path of inner awakening. If we understand this spiritual anatomy, then we will find it much easier to advance in our search for God. For example, the point between the eyebrows the sixth chakra is that part of the body where the mind becomes focused automatically in ecstasy or just in concentration. Understanding this truth, and consciously putting our attention at that point, we discover that the mind actually does become focused there. This is one of the central teachings of yoga. Yoga is a continuous tradition of teachings and techniques that help the ascending soul to understand that there are higher levels of consciousness that transcend lower levels of awareness. Generally speaking, information about the chakras comes from India and from the ancient science of yoga. Yoga is a true and universal teaching, yet yoga does not have a corner on truth. Anyone who finds spiritual freedom or oneness with God, no matter whether they are from an Eastern or Western background, discovers the same truths. It offers nonsectarian guidance and wisdom for those seeking higher awareness, based on centuries of experience. Spiritual awakening is not a vague, mystical experience. All true teachings, although some less specifically than yoga, point to very particular realities. Nor has any deep well-drilling equipment brought up screaming and protesting demons. This concept has no cosmic relevance, but it does have infinite relevance for the individual. We can easily see this relevance in our instinctive responses to life. When we feel uplifted or high, or downcast or low, we use expressions which reflect these feelings. Spiritual awakening implies raising of energy and consciousness in the body. And hellish consciousness, materialistic consciousness-that which takes us away from joy and down into suffering and pain-is always a descent. What yoga does is particularize these truths by showing that outer experiences of joy or sadness are caused by energy moving in the deep spine. When our energy is uplifted in the spine we begin to approach divine consciousness. Locating the Chakras The spinal centers, or chakras, are found at the points where tributary streams of energy prana or life force from the body join the upward flow of energy in the deep or astral spine. The astral, or energy, spine is not the backbone those knobs that can be felt along the back , but runs more or less through the center of the body. Energy flows through the central nervous system and through the astral spine. In our unawakened state, the main energy-flow is downward, away from the brain, and outward to the organs and limbs. The chakras correspond to the spinal plexuses in the physical body, from which nerves branch out to provide energy to the different body parts. As we go deeper in meditation and prayer, uplifting our consciousness, the energy begins to flow upward in the spine. First Chakra The first chakra is located at the base of the spine. It is also called the muladhara, or coccyx center. From this center radiate the nerves that go to the lower parts of the body: Second Chakra An inch and a half above the first chakra is the swadisthana, or sacral center. The nerves from this center operate the reproductive system. Third Chakra Opposite the navel in the astral spine is the manipura, or lumbar center, the nerves from which operate the digestive system and all the internal organs and glands in the abdominal cavity spleen, liver, kidneys, adrenals, etc. Fourth Chakra At the region of the heart in the spine is the anahata, or dorsal center, from which nerves radiate out to the heart, lungs, and chest, and into the arms and hands. Fifth Chakra The vishudha, or cervical center, from which nerves radiate to the throat, neck, and vocal chords, is opposite the throat in the spine. Sixth Chakra The highest spinal center is located in the medulla oblongata, at the base of the brain just above the place where the skull connects with the neck. Its positive pole is the ajna chakra, at the point between the eyebrows. The medulla oblongata is the center through which cosmic energy feeds the entire body with prana life force or conscious cosmic energy. Seventh Chakra The sahasrara chakra, is located in the cranium, at the top of the head. This center is traditionally known as the thousand-petaled lotus, or crown chakra. Functions of the Chakras In addition to their physical functions, the chakras store and distribute

energy and information. They also serve as the location of our psychological or mental tendencies, habits, and desires. In fact, the astral spine is a long, downward extension of the subconscious mind. Our inner struggle to grow and change spiritually takes place between the pull of the soul from above and the pull of matter and material involvement from below. Every unfulfilled desire, every wave of like or dislike, every karmic action, creates a subtle vortex of energy. These energy vortices are held together by centripetal thoughts, such as: To work out all desires or karma in the outer world is, ultimately, not feasible, for out of every fulfilled desire there arise two, or twenty, or a hundred other new desires. These vortices of desire, also called vrittis, enter the subconscious and sink to their respective levels in the spine in the area of a specific chakra, according to the relative grossness or refinement of the energy they express. The more spiritual a vortex, the higher the center around which it settles; the more materialistic a vortex, the lower the center. Very old vortices, as yet unresolved, are submerged, so to speak, by more recently created vortices, and have little or no effect on the waking consciousness. They continue, however, like little ripples on the surface of larger waves, to obscure the clear reflection of the Eternal Spirit, long after the larger waves of the initial desire or feeling have subsided. The energy of these vortices, when released to flow upward, combines to produce a mighty river of energy before which no obstacle can stand. A strong upward flow of energy in the spine dissolves those vortices automatically, just as a strong flow of water in a river dissolves the little eddies along its banks. Riku, Donald, and Goofy appear soon after, where Riku orders Sora to give up, though Sora refuses to leave without Kairi. Sora, believing it to be the end, braces himself, but Goofy rushes in and blocks the blast with his shield. After a fierce battle, Riku is defeated and flees. Jealous and angry at Sora and shamed over his loss of control of the Keyblade, Riku succumbs to his pledge and powers, and becomes consumed by the darkness. Sora and friends manage to travel through the labyrinth of a castle to reach the chapel; there they meet with and confront Maleficent. Escaping back to Riku for help, she is stabbed through the heart by his Keyblade of heart, made from the hearts of the six Princesses. Riku then appears and reveals that Maleficent was merely a pawn of the Heartless, unable to see the darkness swallowing her heart. He then departs and Sora and company travel to the Grand Hall, where the Keyhole and Princesses are located, to find and confront him. There, Sora finds Kairi unconscious on the floor in front of the partially opened Keyhole. He tries to wake her, but Riku appears to tell Sora her heart is missing. Riku continues to tell Sora that Kairi is one of the princesses and that her heart is within him. Sora is able to realize that Riku is no longer in control of his own body. Kairi wakes just in time to see Sora disappear. Donald and Goofy bravely make a stand against Ansem, but both know that, without Sora, they may not be able to stop him. However, before Ansem can attack, Riku projects himself from his stolen body, manages to establish enough control to stop him in his tracks, and warns Kairi and the others that the Heartless called by Ansem will soon overrun the castle at which they heed and run to escape. An apparently non-hostile Heartless arrives; Donald shouts at it to get lost and whacks it over the head with his staff, but Kairi realizes that the Heartless is, in fact, Sora. Surely, it cannot rightly be said that I would give place to Jezebel. And yet, some may have wondered why the focus here at FAF does not spend "as much" time on the "wife submission" doctrine? So, here at FAF , we either have women who are already positive to Christian Polygamy who make posts among us, or some of our posts might be read by presently non-accepting-of-polygyny wives of husbands who are. Now, the fact is, while there are always exceptions to everything, of course , almost every man who has a wife who does not yet embrace Christian Polygamy is highly likely to have tried to use the "wife submission" verses to try to persuade his wife that she is supposed to embrace Christian Polygamy. It could be seen as potentially correct doctrine in the "letter of the Law", but it still fails to persuade a wife, almost every time, because it is not come off as in the Spirit, in the "Spirit of the law". Rather, I am only referring to the concept of "questioning, wondering, preparing for investigation, hypothesizing", etc. He ends up "confirming" her investigation as to whether this is just a "self interest" matter when he uses these "wife submission" verses against her. There is a time for effectively teaching those verses and a time when it fails. When a heated argument between a husband and a wife arises, if he ever resorts to the "wife submission" verses in his self-justification at such a time, he is making himself appear to be exploiting Scripture to self-justify his own agenda against the contributing thoughts of the wife. She might rightly submit, but what he has taught her to think about him is that he will exploit Scripture to "get his way". But if instead, he will refrain himself from resorting to that, especially in such times, but if he instead goes to where she is "at" spiritually and emotionally, showing he CARES about what she thinks and feels, she is more likely willing to JOYFULLY submit, and even be re-assured that her husband will NOT resort to "clobbering her over the head" with the "wife submission" verses. While this might sound "illogical" to the "pragmatic" mind of most of us men, most Godly women I know will often testify to the Spiritual power of what I am sharing here. And while there are always exceptions to everything, and surely some women are simply deliberately "defiant", but it is still best for a man in any case to take the humble, giving, selfless route than to "clobber a woman over the head" with those "wife submission" verses in such a time. But she does this precisely because I do NOT force her. Let that be understood by all who read this, that it is wholly a voluntary matter here. If it helps, I would encourage people to think of it this way. The Lord has given our dear women a blessing that we tend to think of as a sort "intuition". How many times have our women say the following about something? What a blessing our women are for us, for sure! TRUST cannot be "expected" or "demanded". It can only be earned by our own deliberate actions. And our personal credibility decreases dramatically when we appear to be overtly out for own "self-interest", especially if it appears to conflict with the interests of the other person. And contrariwise, the more that you do something for someone else without having hidden agendas or self-interest, the more

TRUST you can build indeed. So, now, to a woman, when a husband brings Christian Polygamy to her, what happens at the "gate"? It is wholly unjust to simply accuse a wife of mere "disobedience" for at least having this understandable "suspicion". But rather than compassionately understand why this is a reasonable "suspicion" for the dear wife to have at first, what is the understandably common, yet dysfunctional, method which many otherwise even Godly men mistakenly do? Hence the reason for getting this message of love-not-force out even that much more. Again, its not that wife is being "disobedient". Rather, he himself is SCARING her by his having the appearance that all he is becoming "all about" is what he wants, appearing as being a selfish man who will exploit Scripture to self-justify his self-exaltation. The man has this made a difficult situation even harder and more difficult! He has sabotaged the situation, making it even "worse" than before. This point is so important to understand that I will re-iterate it. And it is not her fault, but HIS. So, while he might be Scripturally correct, he is Spiritually failing her. And so, what becomes important is to have the wisdom of appropriate timing. Of course, the "wife submission" verses are Scriptural and right doctrine as applied non-tyrannically and not in the chest-pounding mentality. And it does NOT "lobber the woman over the head" with the "wife submission" verses. Instead, it preaches about the man saying to his wife how HE needs to grow in Christ, rather than him pointing a finger at her and telling her how she is simply supposed to "obey" him. And once he effectively "unlocks" that "gate", she herself is more willing to explore the possibility of the meaty truth of Christian Polygamy, to eventually proceed through the process of "paradigm-shifting", whereby old norms and old ways of her thinking are changed willingly and gladly of her own volition. So, I said all that to say this Here at FAF , the pro-polygamy wives we do have here at FAF already know the things which we in general and which I in specifics am sharing here. But the not-yet-embracing-polygyny wives of husbands among us surely need further assurance and comfort that this is not about the "self-interest" of her husband. Such women are not "wrong" to have this "suspicion" at this time. And so, for the not-yet-embracing-polygyny wives who are reading these FAF posts which come in the email box of their husband, if they were to be reading posts which simply and only "lobber them over the head" with the "wife submission" verses, then their "gates" will remain "locked", and this ministry will not have helped those families. In such a case, all of us will have failed them. That is, we also will have comforted her to know that her husband is "at a place" i. Rather, this is about having true power in the Spirit by teaching such a profound message of love in receiving the spirit of wisdom and of revelation on how, how, how to understand how a woman thinks, and that "unlocks" the "gate". The bottom line of this all is, it is not that women need to be taught the "wife submission" verses when it comes to Christian Polygamy. Anyway, I suppose I have begun another "book" here, so I shall bring this to a close. I do pray that I have clarified some things where anyone may have needed it. And I also pray that this might even have been a blessing, if not a revelation, for any who may have needed it. May the selfless love of our Lord Jesus Christ be with us.

**Chapter 8 : "Unlocking" the "Gate" to a Wife's Receptiveness - Love-Not-Force**

*Unlocking the Gate in Our Hearts 1 UNLOCKING THE GATES OF OUR HEARTS there must be a gate that opens in the heart.*

A man participates in a rally calling for reform of U. It is inconsistent, ineffective, and does not promote the common good. The lack of an effective, coherent national policy has led to the introduction of many bills in state legislatures around the country, including in Minnesota, that seek to address the complex issue of immigration. Such bills are a response to the failure of the current federal immigration laws and regulations to halt illegal immigration and the resulting economic, social and fiscal impact this has had on many state and local governments. Enforcement-focused state legislation, however, often divides immigrant families and criminalizes the efforts of those who work with immigrants. State legislation cannot repair a failed national policy. Thus, we seek to reiterate our support for comprehensive immigration reform at the federal level, as well as propose the relevant principles that should guide those reforms. We recognize that finding solutions to the plight of immigrants today will sometimes necessitate the overcoming of boundaries in the heart, not just on the land. People erect walls for protection when they feel threatened. At some point, however, we must reach out to human persons in need, and the demands of our common human nature compel us to open a gate in the wall, so that what human dignity demands is not denied to a sister or brother. But before a gate finds its way into the walls outside, there must be a gate that opens in the heart. This is what the Good Samaritan did: Like the Samaritan, we must see all people, including immigrants and undocumented workers who may be different from us, as children made in the image and likeness of God, and fashion our response to their needs accordingly. Governments merely recognize and respect these rights; they do not create them. The human right to life “the foundation of every other right” implies the right to emigrate. A dignified existence that preserves life requires food, shelter, clothing and economic opportunity. Political instability, economic distress, religious persecution or other conditions that offend basic human dignity may require one to seek these basic necessities in another country. The right to emigrate, however, is not absolute. Immigrants are obliged to respect and abide by the laws and traditions of the countries in which they come to reside, and must work toward building solidarity with citizens of their new country of residence. Catholic teaching also recognizes the sovereignty of nations to secure their borders and make decisions about the identity and number of immigrants they allow into their countries. Yet, we must always make sure that we are not exaggerating these concerns in ways that deny the basic humanitarian needs of good people seeking refuge in our country. It is often true that undocumented workers may break immigration laws to come to the United States. We wish to emphasize that a concern for upholding the law supports the common good. But it is also true that laws that undermine human dignity, separate families and which prevent the exercise of basic human rights are unjust laws in need of reform. Good laws should not and need not exclude the possibility of mercy. The United States is a nation of immigrants and our unique historical experience shows the important contributions “social, cultural and economic” that immigrants have made and continue to make to American society. Although immigrants have not always been received with hospitality, Minnesotans, like all Americans, have a responsibility to comfort and welcome the stranger in their midst. Principled immigration policy We believe, with our brother bishops around the country, that policy proposals in this complex area should be assessed by five key principles: Persons have the right to seek economic opportunities in their homeland; conditions ought to be such that persons can work and support their families in dignity and safety; Persons have the right to migrate to support themselves and their families when they are unable to find work and therefore are unable to support their families at home; Sovereign nations have a right to protect and control their borders for the common good; Refugees and asylum seekers should be afforded protection; and The human rights and human dignity of all persons, including undocumented immigrants, should be respected. In addition, any just immigration policy should also: Uphold the human dignity of all persons and work against any injustice that compromises the dignity of immigrants; Promote and give priority to the reunification of families; and Recognize the rich contribution to the community by those immigrants and migrants who work and live here.

Based on these principles the American bishops support comprehensive immigration policy reform that secures our national borders and provides undocumented immigrants the opportunity to earn permanent residency and eventual citizenship. Such reform should include: Moreover, such reform would include the targeted, proportionate, and humane enforcement of immigration laws. Taking action Legislation at the state level cannot achieve necessary reform of national policy. Such legislation also could result in conflicting laws among the states that could lead to the abuse of human rights, disruptions of families in ways that adversely affect children, and send a message of hostility when Jesus calls us to welcome the stranger and to love others as he has loved us. The more fruitful approach would be for public officials in our state, and all of us as citizens, to petition Congress and the president to courageously enact comprehensive immigration reform. We encourage members of the Minnesota Legislature to reject any measures that are in opposition to the fundamental human dignity of immigrants especially the undocumented; and we encourage the Minnesota congressional delegation in Washington, D. Finally, we ask that people join us in prayer to God for a just, yet merciful solution to the plight of immigrants in our country. The statement was signed by Archbishop John C. There is a very painful side to unforgiveness that Satan does not like us to discuss. He wants to make you feel as though you will lose something by forgiving, but really you have everything to gain and very little to lose. You gain peace and joy, you lose the constant torture of remembering the offense. You gain the love and acceptance of your heavenly Father. You lose the chains of the fear of the incident recurring again. And you lose the agonizing entitlement of living in the cozy little jail cell of your past. Suddenly you are free to move on. You only need to look back now to see how far you have come from the "old you" who kept every offense locked away in the treasure chest of your mind. Dear ones, do not forget: You are a child of the King! Your heavenly Father rules the world and you are His heir. Your life belongs to Him, including the painful events of your past. He cares about you very much! He has provided a way out of the pain: Your Father in heaven wants you to be free from the offense; free to move on and fulfill your destiny in Him. We can be used by God to cover their sins. Next time it might be our turn to be forgiven, and they may be used by God to defend us.
