The price is right, but be aware that this historic hotel feels a little run down. It can be an affordable way to get more space and a full kitchen. It can be difficult to drive and park in Washington D. Buy Metro cards at vending machines inside the Metro stations and top them up as needed. Avoid riding at rush hour if you can because trains can be very crowded. Walking is the best way to see Washington D. Bicycling is another good way to get around Washington D. The city has a Bikeshare program where you can rent a bike from one station and drop it off at another for just a few dollars per day. Learn more at capitalbikeshare.com. Families with young children may want to rent smaller bikes or trailers from a rental shop. Hop-on Hop-off bus tours are a popular way to see the city. A knowledgeable guide shares information about points of interest while you ride. Where to eat There are good restaurants to fit a variety of budgets pretty much everywhere in Washington D. Pi Pizzeria – Rumor has it that this St. Louis pizza chain opened a D. I believe it, because this pizza is truly exceptional. Lebanese Taverna – This restaurant is a D. Capitol Cafe – This cafeteria, located inside the U. Capitol Building, offers a variety of inexpensive options for families with picky eaters like mine. Weather and Seasons Washington D.
