The Washington State Department of Transportation allows reservations to be made online, which is strongly recommended during high season and holiday weekends, as spots are limited and waits can be long. Air access is also possible through Friday Harbor Airport, but float planes are also common in this area and are a wonderful bucket-list experience. Three other ships are anchored at the wharf, making it a great rainy-day excursion for those in Seattle. During the summer, a spray park makes good sprinkler fun for the kids, and so does the model boat floating tank. The Center for Wooden Boats is a great hands-on museum, sometimes offering free public rides on their historic sailboats and steamboats along with rowboat and sailboat rentals. Mount Rainier truly ranks as one of the greats on the list of national historic parks. An active volcano, Mount Rainier is also the most glaciated peak in the contiguous United States, and its ice melt and winter snows feed into five rivers. Around 2 million people visit the park annually for everything from skiing and snowshoeing to hiking and mountain biking. The peak is a popular one for climbers to attempt to summit. Visitors must be aware of bears, mountain lions, cougars and other potentially dangerous wildlife. The rivers can be treacherously fast and deep in the spring. The Muir Snowfield can have unexpected surprises, and weather on Mount Rainier can change dramatically in just half an hour. Reading over the safety warnings and acting accordingly is wise for those without back-country experience.
